The following items must be contained within the application packet:

- A. Completed application form/answers to essay questions
- B. Resume'
- C. Transcript of grades (2.0 GPA minimum) or evidence of acceptable performance for vocational school for the previous semester/quarter.
- D. Evidence of continued full-time enrollment for the upcoming quarter/semester.
- E. One letter of recommendation from a person not related to you.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Applications will be judged according to the following criteria:

1.	Neatness & completeness of application	(15 points)
2.	Answers to short essay questions	(60 points)
3.	Resume'	(15 points)
4.	Letters of recommendation	(10 points)

The scholarship recipients will be notified by phone or mail. A check will be mailed to a student's educational institution.
