Meeting of December 13, 2018

Employment. The Board approved Bonnie Hunter as Food Service Director and Moises Juarez-Paredes as High Assistant Wrestling Coach. The Board approved Kaitlyn Sachs (pending receipt of Authorization) and Kayla Villagomez (pending receipt of Authorization) as Guest Teachers. The Board approved Jazmin Pena and Kayla Villagomez as Classified guest employees.

Items from the Audience. Teachers, Jill Gosar and Tate Smith requested permission for an end of year field trip for the 6th Grade class to go to Santa Fe, New Mexico. Band Director, Jason Paschall updated the Board on the band program for the District. The Marching Band had a successful season with 2 first place prizes and a second place prize at State. He reported 126 students are participating in the band program, 5th grade through 12th grade. He reported on the progress made on the goals he developed when he arrived 13 months ago. He listed the various needs of the program regarding instrument repairs, new instruments, cases for instruments, etc.

Superintendent Report. Mr. Webb reported on conversations with TSJC regarding their vocational program and possible expansions of the program. The LED lighting project is moving forward with supplies and equipment being delivered and work scheduled to begin during Christmas Break. The District will be receiving a grant that will expand the bullying prevention programs currently in use and provide training for the staff and others in bullying prevention.
