## Meeting of August 12, 2021

**Resignations.** The Board accepted the resignations of John Camponeschi as a MS Social Studies Teacher; Jake Flanagan as a MS Science Teacher; Emily Logan as a HS Science Teacher; Janene Mondragon as a MS ELA Teacher; and Alexis Wingert as a Marsh/BME Paraprofessional

**Employment.** The Board employed Brandon Fuller as a MS 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Science Teacher; Grace Graham as a BME 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Teacher; David Morgan as a HS Social Studies Teacher; Robbie Remington as a MS 8<sup>th</sup> Grade ELA Teacher; Ryan Rumley as a MS 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Social Studies Teacher; and Bowen Soden as a BME 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Teacher; Maria Hernandez and Irene Ortiz as part-time Food Service employees; John Plane as a Marsh Special Ed Paraprofessional; Jessica Rivera as a Marsh/BME Paraprofessional; and Andres Torres as a MS Football Coach. **Work Session.** Prior to the start of the regular meeting the Board and Administration Team held a work session to discuss strategies and goals for the 2021-22 school year.

**Items from the Audience.** The Board heard presentations from Rio Grande County Judge Barb Zollars on the SLV Mock Trial Program, and from Marianna King regarding communication tower hazards.

**Bill Metz Elementary Report.** Principal Gabe Futrell reported 2021 Spring CMAS scores were down by 2% statewide, but Bill Metz Elementary scores remained even at 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, and increased at both 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades. **Discussion Items.** The Board discussed policy and tabled a possible ballot issue changing term limits.

**Action Items.** The Board approved a Resolution for Exception to Policy BCB and a Resolution Addressing Instructional Time and Attendance during the 2021-2022 school year; approved Schneider Electric to proceed on proposals for improvements at both the Middle School and DELTA Center; approved proceeding on negotiations for the purchase of a building that would allow for the implementation of a future daycare; and temporarily approved a number of policies.

**Other Action Items.** The Board approved minutes from the previous meetings, financial reports, an Agreement with Wall, Smith, Bateman & Associates for the FY21 Fiscal Audit, non-eligible student transportation requests, a requestion to Fox, Inc., in the amount of \$26,028.96 for Band Saw Starting Equipment and a requestion to Curriculum Associates in the amount of \$10,625.00 for an iReady subscription.
