1. **Utility Easement at 100-Acre Property Site** **Staff Responsible – Sturges**

The board is asked to consider a proposal under threat of condemnation from the East Cherry Creek Valley Water and Sanitation District for a proposed acquisition of a 30-foot-wide permanent and a 50-foot-wide temporary construction easement on the district's 100-acre land site located at Harvest Road and the 6th Avenue extension. Bowes and Company completed an appraisal and valued the requested easement at \$34,300. District attorneys at Caplan and Earnest negotiated a proposed settlement figure of \$34,000 with ECCV. This easement is submitted for board of education consideration.

2. Fire Lane and Two Utility Easements at Hinkley High School Staff Responsible – Sturges

(Attachment II-D-2)

As part of the Hinkley High School remodel, the city of Aurora is requesting two easements. The first easement is a utility and fire lane easement and the second easement is a separate utility easement. Both easements are required under the municipal code of Aurora, Colorado. The utility and fire lane easement description is attached (see “Utility and Fire Lane Easement”). This utility and fire lane easement will contain a 0.431-acre area and a 0.606-acre area (see exhibits A and B under the “Utility and Fire Lane Easement”). The second utility easement description is also attached (see “Utility Easement”). This second utility easement consists of four areas of APS property located at Hinkley High School. These areas are described in the “Utility Easement” as follows: 0.166 acres (see Exhibit A), 0.006 acres (see Exhibit B), 0.004 acres (see Exhibit C) and 0.003 acres (see Exhibit D). The two easements are submitted to the board of education for consideration.

D. DIVISION OF SUPPORT SERVICES**1. Milk and Dairy Products Bid****Staff Responsible – Sturges**

(Attachment IV-D-1)

The district solicited bids for milk and dairy products for 2005. Included in this bid are 35 line items for various dairy products. The largest annual expenditure is for milk; the district serves approximately two million half-pints annually. In an effort to solicit competitive pricing, nutrition services invited five vendors to submit bids. Bids were received from Robinson Dairy and Sinton Dairy, with Sinton Dairy having the lowest bid.

Milk prices have increased. This increase is due to the “New Look of Milk.” The containers will now be plastic bottles instead of the paper cartons. Studies have shown that students are much more accepting of the plastic bottle and milk consumption increases. Cartons have always had the problem of leaking and being difficult to open.

Both dairies bid on all three options. The cost of milk is expected to go down after the fall season so based on this we are recommending we accept Bid Option One which allows for variable pricing based on the raw milk price as determined by the United States Department of Agriculture Federal Market Order. Sinton Dairy sends a monthly report stating the raw milk price.

Recommendation: The board of education award the bid to Sinton Dairy based on Bid Option One, which is variable pricing with opportunity for monthly increases or decreases. The estimated value of this contract is \$500,000 for the one-year term.

2. Sand Creek Lateral and Antero Reservoir Water Rights**Staff Responsible – Sturges**

(Attachment IV-D-2)

On June 21, 2005, the board was asked to consider a proposed non-monetary exchange of Antero Reservoir Water Rights owned by the district for Sand Creek Lateral land owned by the Denver Water Board located at the school site on Peoria Street.

Upon acquiring the title for this land, the district will be able to grant all of the required utility and fire lane easements as required by the city of Aurora.

Recommendation: The board of education approve the proposal as submitted.
