

PEYTON PANTHERS BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

INTRODUCTION

Booster Club Scholarships are a one-time \$750.00 grant designed to assist students pursuing further education. The scholarships are intended to recognize outstanding graduating students involved in Peyton Senior High School programs. Applicants will be evaluated on the basis of their academic achievement, extracurricular activities, community involvement, and supplemental subjective information. Applicants are encouraged to think outside the box with regard to the creation of their application.

ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for a scholarship, a student must meet the following criteria:

- 1. **Residence:** Graduating senior involved in Peyton Senior High School programs.
- 2. **Academic Achievement:** Student must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, or a SAT score of 1200 combined verbal, math, and writing or ACT of 18.
- 3. **Higher Education**: Student must enroll in an institution of higher learning (a university, college, junior college, technical school, beauty or art school) within 8 months of graduation. Student will receive award disbursement after student submits verification of enrollment to the Peyton Panthers Booster Club Board of Directors.
- 4. **Application Form:** Student must create and submit an application and all supporting documentation (letters of recommendation, essay, and transcripts), on or before the required date and time of submittal (**May 3, 2018**).
- 5. **Submission**: The completed submittal must be delivered to the Peyton Panthers Booster Club by **May 3, 2018, 5:00pm**. Acceptable formats include electronic (e-mail, USB flash drive) or hard copy. Applications can be e-mailed to the Peyton Panther Booster Club at peytonpbc@gmail.com or hard copy submitted to the PPBC mailbox within the Peyton High School main office.

SCHOLARSHIP TERMS

Each award will be made payable to the student upon verification of enrollment in an institute of higher learning to the Peyton Panthers Booster Club Board of Directors. In the event the selected student fails to enroll and commence attendance at a qualifying institution within 8 months after graduation, the scholarship from the Peyton Panthers Booster Club will be forfeited. There are no restrictions on the use of scholarship.
