All 6th and 7th grade students will receive a complimentary bread baking kit after the presentation to make 2 loaves of bread. We hope that families will enjoy one loaf and then bake the other to be donated to a local charity. If you do choose to donate your baked bread, return the baked bread to school in the plastic bag included in your kit.

In addition, following the assembly, we are able to accommodate 30 students for an after school baking session from 2 - 3 pm. The first 30 students to return this form will be able to participate in the after school baking session.
