INTERNAL BOARD POLICIES

Meetings

The meetings of the Board of Trustees are basic to the operation of the Board. All official action of the Board shall be taken when the Board is in formal session. The Board meetings are not public meetings; however, other than closed sessions, they are meetings of the Board of Trustees held in public.

Board meetings will be conducted according to the California Government Code, the California Education Code, those Internal Board Policies, Bylaws of the Board, and the New Robert's Rules of Order, Revised Edition 1993 (Barnes & Noble). Conflicts between these sources shall be resolved as follows: state law takes precedence; then Board Policies; then Robert's Rules.

The Board cannot take action on items not listed on the agenda, other than in an emergency/special need situation as specified in the Brown Act, Government code Section 54950 et seq. Board members may respond briefly to statements made or questions posed by persons exercising their rights to address the Board under Government Code Section 54954.3 and Education Code Section 35145.5. In addition, on their own initiative, or in response to questions posed by the public, members of the Board may ask a question for clarification, make a brief announcement or a brief report on the member's district-related activities, provide a reference to staff or other resources for factual information, or request staff to report back at a subsequent meeting concerning any matter. Furthermore, Board members or the Board itself, may take action to direct staff to place a matter of business on a future agenda.

Because Board members do not function officially as individuals, the Board meeting presents an opportunity for the school program to be discussed and appraised, and for individual ideas and opinions to be aired as the Board works toward democratic decisions. In addition, the meeting provides an appropriate place for hearing and considering items of interest or concern to individual community members or groups.
