CONTRACTOR PRE-QUALIFICATION

Oakland Unified School District has elected to become subject to the California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (CUPCCAA). The District hereby invites all licensed contractors who are interested in performing public works and maintenance projects to sign up for inclusion on the District's qualified bidder's list Calendar Year 2013. Interested Contractors must fill out and send back the attached CUPCCAA Pre-Qualification Questionnaire.

The California Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act is under the umbrella of the California Uniform Construction Cost Accounting Commission (CUPCCAC) and provides for alternative bidding procedures when an agency performs public project work by contract.

Public Contract Code Section 22034

Each public agency that elects to become subject to the uniform construction accounting procedures set forth in Article 2 (commencing with Section 22010) shall enact an informal bidding ordinance to govern the selection of contractors to perform public projects pursuant to subdivision (b) of Section 22032. The ordinance shall include all of the following:

- (a) The public agency shall maintain a list of qualified contractors, identified according to categories of work. Minimum criteria for development and maintenance of the contractors list shall be determined by the commission.
- (b) All contractors on the list for the category of work being bid or all construction trade journals specified in Section 22036, or both all contractors on the list for the category of work being bid and all construction trade journals specified in Section 22036, shall be mailed a notice inviting informal bids unless the product or service is proprietary.
- (c) All mailing of notices to contractors and construction trade journals pursuant to subdivision (b) shall be completed not less than 10 calendar days before bids are due.
- (d) The notice inviting informal bids shall describe the project in general terms and how to obtain more detailed information about the project, and state the time and place for the submission of bids.
- (e) The governing body of the public agency may delegate the authority to award informal contracts to the public works director, general manager, purchasing agent, or other appropriate person.
- (f) If all bids received are in excess of one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000), the governing body of the public agency may, by adoption of a resolution by a four-fifths vote, award the contract, at one hundred thirty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$137,500) or less, to the lowest responsible bidder, if it determines the cost estimate of the public agency was reasonable.



Oakland Unified School District Bidder Requirement

Bidders' attention is directed to the following items set forth in the Information for Bidders, the General Conditions, or Supplementary General Conditions.

- A. Compliance with the OUSD Local Employment, Disabled Veterans Business Participation Program and Project Labor Agreement.
- B. Conditions of employment to be observed and prevailing wage rates to be made under the Labor Compliance Program.
- C. DVBE information form must be submitted within twenty-four (24) hours of the deadline for bid submittal.
- D. Compliance with the LOCAL, SMALL LOCAL AND SMALL LOCAL RESIDENT BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM. For Additional information please visit the Facilities Department page at: www.ousd.k12.ca.us
- E. Project Labor Agreement: The District has entered into a Project Labor Agreement with Building and Construction Trade Council of Alameda County, AFL-CIO.

The Oakland Unified School District ("District") has adopted a Contractor Pre-Qualification Program pursuant to California Public Contract Code 20111.5 for all Public Works contracts with a value estimated at \$15,000 or more.

Interested businesses will also be required to meet the District's Pre-qualification standards as outlined below.

Pre-Qualification Process:

- Submit a complete and signed Contractor Qualification Questionnaire (CUPCCAA) for all projects.
- Bidders must be pre-qualified at least five business days prior to the bid opening date.

PLEASE NOTE THAT BIDS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED FROM PRE-QUALIFIED BIDDERS. BIDS SUBMITTED BY NON PRE-QUALIFIED FIRMS WILL BE REJECTED AS INVALID.
