

OPTIC Graphic Organizer

Overview	Write a brief <i>overview</i> of the image: in one or more complete sentence(s), what is this image about?
Parts	Notice all parts, noting important details - anything: color, figures, textures, groupings, shadings, patterns, numbers, etc.
Title & Text	Use the title to clarify the subject of the image. Consider both literal and metaphoric meanings. What does the title suggest? Is there any text in the image—a caption, or words in the image itself? What might this text suggest?
Interrelationships	Specify the <i>interrelationships</i> in the image. In other words, how the parts are related, both to one another and the image as a whole. Consider how the parts come together to create a mood or convey an idea or argument.
Conclusion	Write a <i>conclusion paragraph</i> about the image as a whole: think about what the artist, photographer, creator, or designer might be trying to capture and convey, and what ideas, arguments, or implications this image presents
