- 2. Expected family contribution (as determined on the FAFSA/Cal Grant) under \$20,000.
- 3. Scholarship must be used toward an accredited 2-year or 4-year college, vocational school or other accredited program in the fall of 2022.
- 4. Participation in an extracurricular activity (please describe below).
- 5. Participation in community service (please describe below).
- 6. Submit a previously written essay (i.e., a Common Application essay or a UC Personal Insight Question response) that reveals who you are or the background where you have come from.
