## INNOVATIONS & LEARNING

### World Language Lab

The Brookfield High School (BHS) Language Lab platform has provided the World Language and English for speakers of other languages (ESOL) teams with a multitude of ways to effectively communicate with students while promoting cooperative learning. Teachers facilitate language learning as they provide individualized, targeted instruction and feedback for students to improve upon their proficiency and advance their learning. Teachers also deliver interactive lessons to build students' interpersonal, interpretive, and presentational communication skills in French, Spanish and English (for our English Language Learners).



The Language Lab has also been utilized to provide students with opportunities to participate in the National French and Spanish Language Exam Contests. The technology used in the Language Lab offers a personalized language learning environment that is well aligned with our French and Spanish programs. With the success of the Language Lab at BHS, we are looking forward to implementing a World Language Lab at Whisconer next year.

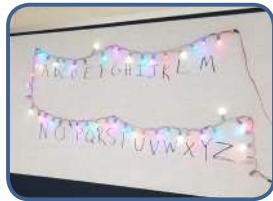

## BOARD OF EDUCATION

### 2019-2020 Budget Proposal from Dr. Barile

The Board of Education received the first presentation of the Superintendent’s recommended budget for the 2019-2020 school year. The budget reflects a 4.4% increase which includes 1.4% in additional needs over the status quo budget with a 3% increase for contractual and mandated costs. Dr. Barile presented two weeks earlier than in years prior, allowing the Board additional time to dissect all items in preparation for a more thorough discussion at its next meeting Wednesday, December 19, 2018.
