BC Calculus Summer Assignment Part 1:

This year's summer assignment will be completed on the online platform <u>DeltaMath</u>. In order to access the content, you will need to create an account. Visit <u>deltamath.com</u>, and in the top right hand corner of the screen, click "create account". Select "student." Enter the teacher code **9088888**. Under class, select "BC Calculus." Enter your information and use your <u>school email</u> <u>account</u>. Click "Create Account." (If you already have a DeltaMath account, log in and click "Tools", then "Manage Login and Teachers". Click "Add Teacher" and use teacher code 908888, and then select the class "BC Calculus".)

Once you are logged in, you should see the summer assignment on your home screen. There are several exercises that you must complete. Each exercise has only two questions. You have as many attempts as you want to get the two questions right. All exercises are due at midnight on August 30. This will be your first quiz grade.
