Pre-Calculus will provide you with an honors-level study of advanced functions, analytic geometry, trigonometry, and data analysis in preparation for calculus, either AP or at the university level. We will be covering a wide variety of topics at a fast pace. Students should be prepared to explore and discover much of the mathematics through collaboration with other students and problem-based learning.
