

It's Dandy to Get Candy!

- 1. Get a partner, 2 Candy game boards, 2 dot dice, 1 math symbol dice, colored chips and an expo marker.
- 2. Decide which partner will go first.
- 3. The first player will roll the dice and solve the math equation that is rolled.
- 4. The partner will agree or disagree with the answer given. If he or she disagrees, they must explain why they think the equation has been solved incorrectly and then they must give the correct answer.
- 5. The player will put the number of colored chips on their candy mat that was the sum of an addition equation. If the player rolled a subtraction equation they must remove the answer from their candy mat.
- 6. Each player will tally the math functions they roll during their turn.
- 7. The winner is the player with the most chips at the end of the playing time or the one who fills up their board first.
