- 3. Draw a conclusion, **using evidence from the text**, about why the Socs respond to Ponyboy and Johnny with so much **aggression**.
- 4. Was it **morally** wrong for Johnny to kill the Soc? Why or why not? **Use evidence from the text** to prove your answer.
- 5. Re-read the parts on **pg. 61** about the shirt that Dally gives to Ponyboy. Consider the situation that Ponyboy is in, and **use the text** to explain what the shirt **symbolizes**.
- 6. Based on what we know about the society in The Outsiders, how do you think the community would judge Ponyboy and Johnny for what happened? How would they likely judge the Socs?
