- Collection of different populations that live together in an area
- **ANSWER-** Community

■ Process in which bacteria convert nitrates into nitrogen gas

■ **ANSWER- Denitrification**

- Process in which organisms use chemical energy to produce carbohydrates

- **Answer-** Chemosynthesis

Question 4

- Group of ecosystems that have the same climate and similar dominant communities

- **Answer- Biome**

Question 5

- Organism that can capture energy and use it to produce food

■ **Answer-Autotroph**

Question 6

- Total amount of living tissue within a trophic level
- **Answer – Biomass**

- Each step in a food chain or food web
- **Answer- Trophic Level**

Question 8

- Combined parts of the planet in which all life exists
- **Answer- Biosphere**

Question 9

- Process in which water evaporates from the leaves of plants

- **Answer- Transpiration**

Question 10

- Consumer that feeds on plant and animal remains and other dead matter
- **Answer- Detritivore**

- A collection of all organisms that live in a particular place, together with their physical environment
- **Answer- Ecosystem**

■ Process in which autotrophs use light energy to make carbohydrates

■ **Answer- Photosynthesis**

■ **Heterotrophs that eat both plants and animals**

■ **Answer- Omnivores**

- Rate at which organic matter is created by producers
- **Answer- Primary productivity**
