List three motives behind the European race for colonies	ECONOMIC COMPETITION FOR RAW MATERIALS AND MARKETS TO SELL GOODS; NATIONAL PRIDE; RACISM; TO CHRISTIANIZE AND CIVILIZE NON-EUROPEANS; SOCIAL DARWINISM
List two technological advantages Europeans had over Africans	SUPERIOR WEAPONS AND TECHNOLOGY RAILROADS, CABLES, STEAMSHIPS AND MEDICINE (QUININE)
List two internal factors that made Africa vulnerable to European conquest	GREAT DIVERSITY OF LANGUAGE AND CULTURE; LOW LEVELS OF TECHNOLOGY-ESPECIALLY WEAPONS; TRIBAL COMPETITION AND WARFARE KEPT AFRICANS FROM FORMING A UNITED FRONT
The Colonization of Africa	
List two outcomes of the Berlin Conference	Africa was divided b/t 14 European countries; arbitrary distribution of African language and ethnic groups; African ways of life changed forever by European influences
List three groups that fought over territory & resources in S. Africa	Zulu, Boers—Dutch settlers, and British
List two outcomes of the Boer War	South Africa became self-governing, Dutch lost control to British
