### RESOLUTION OF THE GANADO CHAPTER

**Respectfully Reappointing ██████████ to Serve a Two-Year Term as a Parent

Representing Ganado Community**

#### WHEREAS;

1. The Ganado Chapter is a duly certified local governing entity recognized by the Navajo Nation Council through 11 N.N.C. § 10(A), to advocate and address the needs and development of the local people to interact with other departments of the Navajo Nation, federal and local agencies which serve and affect the Navajo Nation; and

2. The Ganado Chapter is a Governance Certified Chapter of the Navajo Nation vested authority under 26 N.N.C. § 101 et. seq; and

3. Ganado Chapter pursuant to Navajo Nation central governing policies and procedures, has direct responsibility and authority to promote, protect and preserve the interest and general welfare of its community, memberships, programs and property; and

4. Ganado Chapter is entitled to initiate plans to make unique decisions and recommendations while striving to meet the needs of all educational pupils enrolled with the Ganado Unified School District (GUSD) No. 20; and

5. Ganado Chapter recognizes that GUSD boundaries does not only provide educational opportunities to District 17 communities (Ganado, Kinlichee, Cornfields, Klagetoh, Wide Ruins and Greasewood) membership but includes adjacent communities such as Nazlini, St. Michaels, Window Rock, Fort Defiance, Jeddito and Whitecone; and

6. Ganado Chapter is aware that PAC's duties and responsibilities directly revolve vacuuming in parents to support their children, to be part of their unique learning circle, to educate and instill learning techniques at home; and

7. Ganado Chapter sincerely supports and believes the moto of "it takes a village to educate a child", everyone has to have some knowledge pertaining to curriculum versus measuring instruments, school operational requirements, State education system requirements, data assessment and analyzing, ...just to highlight a few areas.
