Any student that plagiarizes and/or cheats will receive a zero on the assignment/assessment, detention, and a call home. If the student continues to plagiarize and/or cheat a parent/teacher meeting with administration will be scheduled to discuss further actions.

Extra Credit (EC): Keep in mind that extra credit is **NOT** a right, it is a privilege. Therefore, EC assignments will **NOT** be given as a last resort to bring up a final grade. So please take advantage of the opportunity when it is offered.

Extra credit will be offered on occasion through the following opportunities:

- ✓ **Games-** Winners of review games will receive extra credit.
- Handouts- Extra credit will be available through handouts (i.e. crosswords, word searches, worksheets, etc). Point values will vary.
- Projects and Quizzes- I will offer extra credit for questions answered correctly on exams and projects.
