

3 years of History/Social Science	2 years of History/Social Science

2 years of Math (must pass a year of Algebra)	3 years of Math (up to Algebra 2) Recommend 4 years
3 years of Science (must include Biology, Chemistry, and Physics)	2 years of Science (Life & Physical) Recommend 3 years






