• Notes & Class work (30% for CP):

- 1) Notes will be taken daily.
- 2) Notes will be graded based on: Completeness, Organization and Neatness.
- 3) <u>In case of a student's absence:</u> Student has the choice to one of the following options:
 a) Attend Virtual Office Hours to make up their Notes/ Assignment, <u>(Preferred Choice)</u>.
 - b) Copy the notes from another Student.
- 4) Class work includes practice worksheets and textbook problems.



Homework & Class Discussion (10% for CP)

Grade for this Category is based on the following:

- a) Verbally responding to in Class Meet Prompt or asking questions that will benefit learning.
- b) Complete and Turn in all Assignments on time.
- c) Attend Virtual Office Hours to complete any missing assignments or quizzes.

Labs & Projects: (20% for CP)

This class is a laboratory based. All Labs and Projects are formative assessments. Please note that, failure to complete and turn in the lab report will jeopardize your grade in the class.

• Test & Quizzes: (30% for CP)

- a) Quizzes will be administered at the end of each section.
- b) Tests will be at the end of each chapter. Test dates will be posted at least 3 days prior to the test

• Finals: (10% for CP):

At end of the semester, Students will be given a Final that covers the material discussed throughout the semester. To help prepare for the finals; Students will be given a project, research paper, a lab or a semester review packet.

- All assignments will be posted on Microsoft Teams in your Class OneNote.
- All-important announcements will be posted via Microsoft Teams Calendar and on your Teams General Channel "Posts".
- Grades will be posted and updated Biweekly online via Aries program.

Classroom Policies:

- 1) <u>Academic Dishonesty:</u> According to the district guidelines and policies, if a student copied, shared, or submitted another student assignment, he/she will receive <u>No Credit</u> and <u>No Make Up</u> for the assignment.
- 2) Make up time with "No Late Penalty" for Absent students: According to CVUSD board guidelines, students with excused absences will receive the same number of their absent days to make up their work. For example, if you were absent for two days, you will receive two school days to make up the assignments. Any make up after that will be considered late and graded out of 70%.
- 3) <u>Late Assignments:</u> The Late assignment must be <u>completed</u> to receive a 70%. It is the students' responsibility to check their grade on Aries and to see which assignments they are missing. Failure to turn in your missing assignments will jeopardize your grade in class and participating in extra credit.
