The Children's Center School is located at 310 Madison Terrace and provides services for severely disabled students in Montgomery County, Alabama. It is a very unique school, serving students in grades K-12. Most of the students are multi-disabled, non-verbal and in wheelchairs. Other disabilities represented are severe intellectually disabled, autism and traumatic brain injury. Medical fragility is an issue that must be addressed each day as teachers and staff work with students. Communication, mobility and motor skills, self-help skills and pre-vocational skills are major components of instruction at Children's Center.


Our student-centered classrooms are based on collaboration, project-based learning, technology integration, and communication between students, teachers, staff members, and parents.
