Damage To Chromebook Is First Noticed

- Teacher conducts a brief investigation to acquire more information (It is imperative to get student names)
- 2. Teacher sends an email to K. Sheaffer, J. Torres, and E. Garza informing them of the damage and all information acquired (including student names)
- 3. The chromebook will be sent to K. Sheaffer to assess the damage



Finding Out Who's Responsible

- J. Torres will use the information sent, by the teacher, to further investigate the incident
- 2. J. Torres will issue consequences according the the WIS Agenda and inform parents of the incident and there will be a cost, to repair the damages, to follow



Billing For Damages

- K. Sheaffer will inform E. Garza, J. Torres and L Torres of the cost to repair the damages (whethe covered or not covered under warranty)
- 2. J. Torres will inform parents of the cost to repair the damages
- 3. L. Torres will issue the appropriate charge to the student's account.
