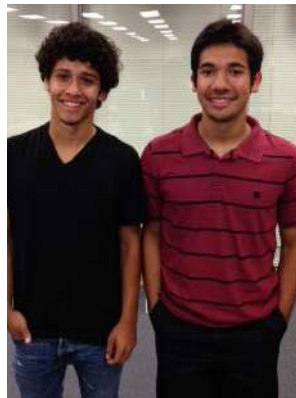




WINNING WOLVES

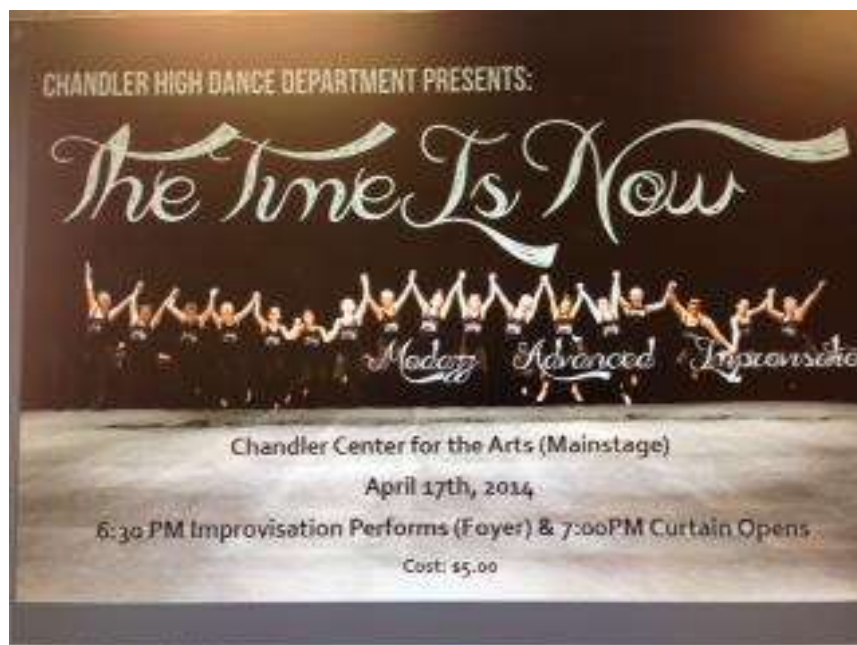
