Expectations:

Students will be expected to follow all school rules including those pertaining to dress code and cell phone use.

Students will be expected to behave in a manner that is conducive to the learning environment.

Textbooks, paper, and pencils will be daily requirements.

Grade Calculation:

Tests--50%

Quizzes--30%

Assignments--20%

To calculate your grade, you may use the following algorithm.

$$.5(\text{Test Average}) + .3(\text{Quiz Average}) + .2(\text{Assignment Average})$$

Students will have daily assignments. Assignments may be turned in during class the next day or may be uploaded and submitted through Schoology.

Each assignment will be worth 20 points. The points from the daily assignments will be added together to form one grade for the week worth 100 points. Assignments will be graded for effort. In order to receive full credit for the assignment, every problem must be attempted using the correct procedure as taught in class. If less than half of the assignment was attempted, then no credit will be given. Daily assignments will be scored as 20 points (full credit--all were problems were attempted), 10 points (half credit--at least half of the problems were attempted), 0 points (less than half of the problems were attempted). Students who indicate that they could not complete the assignment due to a lack of understanding will be given an option to try again after receiving further explanation.

Tests and quizzes will be graded for accuracy.

Supplies:

Paper, pencil, scientific calculator, notebook or binder

Precalculus students will be issued a TI-84 graphing calculator.

Calculus students will not need a calculator.
