Chalkable

- A total points system will be used in all business courses.
- The Chalkable online grade book is updated frequently.
- When you see a "0" ZERO listed next to an assignment, it means you made a zero on the work because either you didn't study or you failed to produce the work when it was due.
- If you see "MA" Missing Assignment next to an assignment, it means you were not in class when the work was due or we took a test, quiz, etc. "MA" averages as a zero. If you are eligible to make up the work, then "MA" will be changed once the work has been completed & graded.
