All courses are taught by certified nurses. Topics include vital signs, bed making, bed baths, transfers, lifts and other nursing assistant skills. Emphasis will be placed on responsibilities and limitations as well as legal and ethical aspects of the nursing assistant role.

REQUIREMENTS:

- * Students will be provided with (75) hours of Nursing Theory and (60) hours of increased supervised clinical instruction.
- * Students must submit a completed application including recent Physical and PPD (tuberculosis) test results prior to start of class (forms are included in application packet & must be signed by a physician)

ATTENDANCE:

- * Students are expected to attend 8 clinical sessions and approximately 25 sessions of class time. (2 1/2 months)
- * Successful completion of this program will prepare individuals to take the State of Connecticut Nurse Aide Competency Exam.
- * Classes are offered throughout the year, contingent upon enrollment.
- * Classes limited to 10 students
