

College Preparatory Mathematics Website Guide

Andersen Junior High uses the College Preparatory Mathematics (CPM) curriculum. Below is information to help both you and your student navigate the additional support available on the CPM website.

1) Website: <http://www.cpm.org>

2) Students:

- a) On the left-hand side of the CPM website under the “Student Support” label click on “Homework Help”.
- b) Scroll down and choose your “Core Connections Course”.
- c) From the course drop-down menu choose the chapter you need help with. This will open a page with a list of all the lessons available in the chapter.
- d) Click on the lesson you need help with. This opens another page with additional problems to work on, with hints as you need them. The correct answer is also available to click on to check your work.

3) Parents:

- a) If you would like your child to have additional work to help them better understand the concept, there are also tools for you available on the CPM website.
- b) Under “Parent Support” click on “How to Help Your Student”.
- c) Under “How to Help Your Student” click on “Parent Guide”. This link helps you to understand what your child is currently learning in the classroom.
- d) Choose your student’s course from the drop-down menu.
- e) From the drop-down menu choose the chapter your student’s working on. This will download a PDF file with a complete description of the topics covered.
- f) Additionally, there is a Core Connections Checkpoint menu that will help you with key concepts your student is working on.
