Type One: Brainstorming: timed, quota, no negative feedback, draws out background knowledge, engagement.

Type Two: Quick quiz: timed, quota, corrective feedback, checks for understanding, encourages daily study, test vocabulary.

Type Three: First draft: FCAs focus on style, organization, idea, and conventions; improves writing through repeated practice; allows for quick, clear, manageable feedback.

Type Four: Second draft: peer edited, new FCAs, works on revising and accountability.

Type Five: Publishable work: promotes pride and sense of audience.
