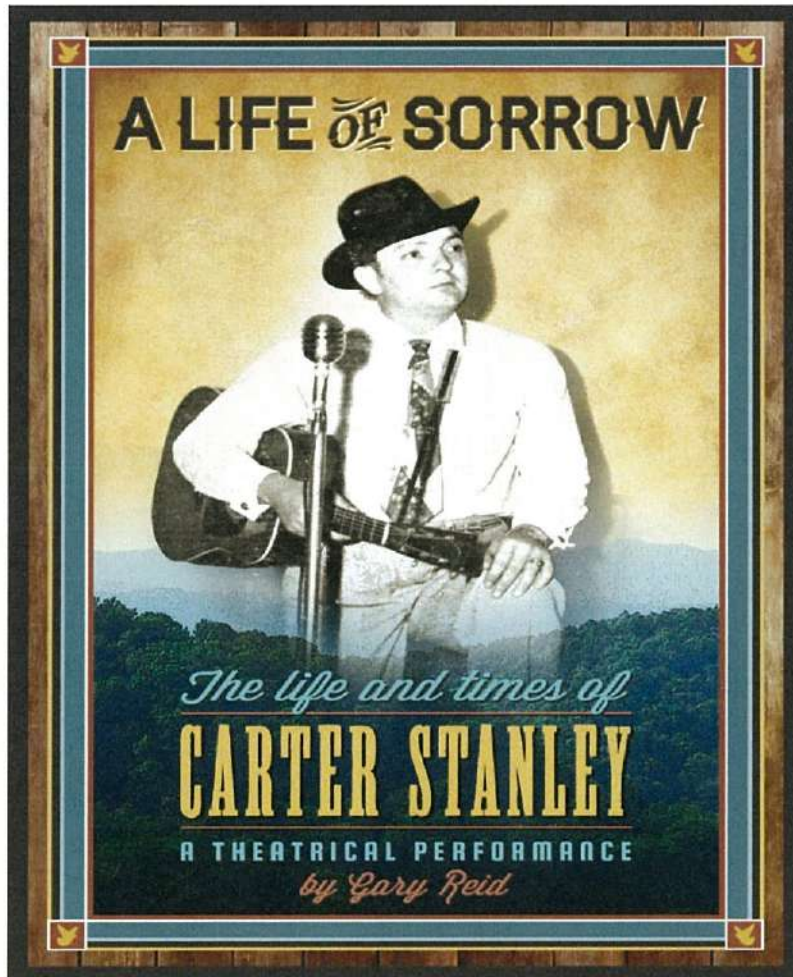

The Griswold Youth Football Association Inc. provides tackle football and cheerleading programs to children residing in the towns of Griswold, Lisbon, Voluntown, Canterbury, Preston and Sprague (Baltic, Hanover and Versailles).

Griswold youth football teams and cheerleading squads are all formed based solely upon a child's age and we compete in the 13 team Southern New England Youth Football Conference (SNEYFC). We hope that you come out and join the fun!

Griswold Youth Football has 5 divisions:

14u Division – players who are 13 and 14 years old (no 9th graders)

12u Division – players who are 11 and 12 years old

10u Division – players who are 9 and 10 years old

8u Division – players who are 7 and 8 years old

Flag Football – players who are 5 and 6 years old

Griswold Youth Cheerleading has 4 divisions:

Seniors – 12, 13 and 14 years old (no 9th graders)

Juniors – 10 and 11 years old

Micros – 8 and 9 years old

Minis – 7 years old and younger but must be 4 years old by August 1st

Registration Fees

Registration fees for the 2018 season will remain the same at \$120.00 per tackle football player and cheerleader and \$80.00 per flag football player and flag cheerleader. Note: the mandatory walk-a-thon contribution is rolled into the overall cost listed above.

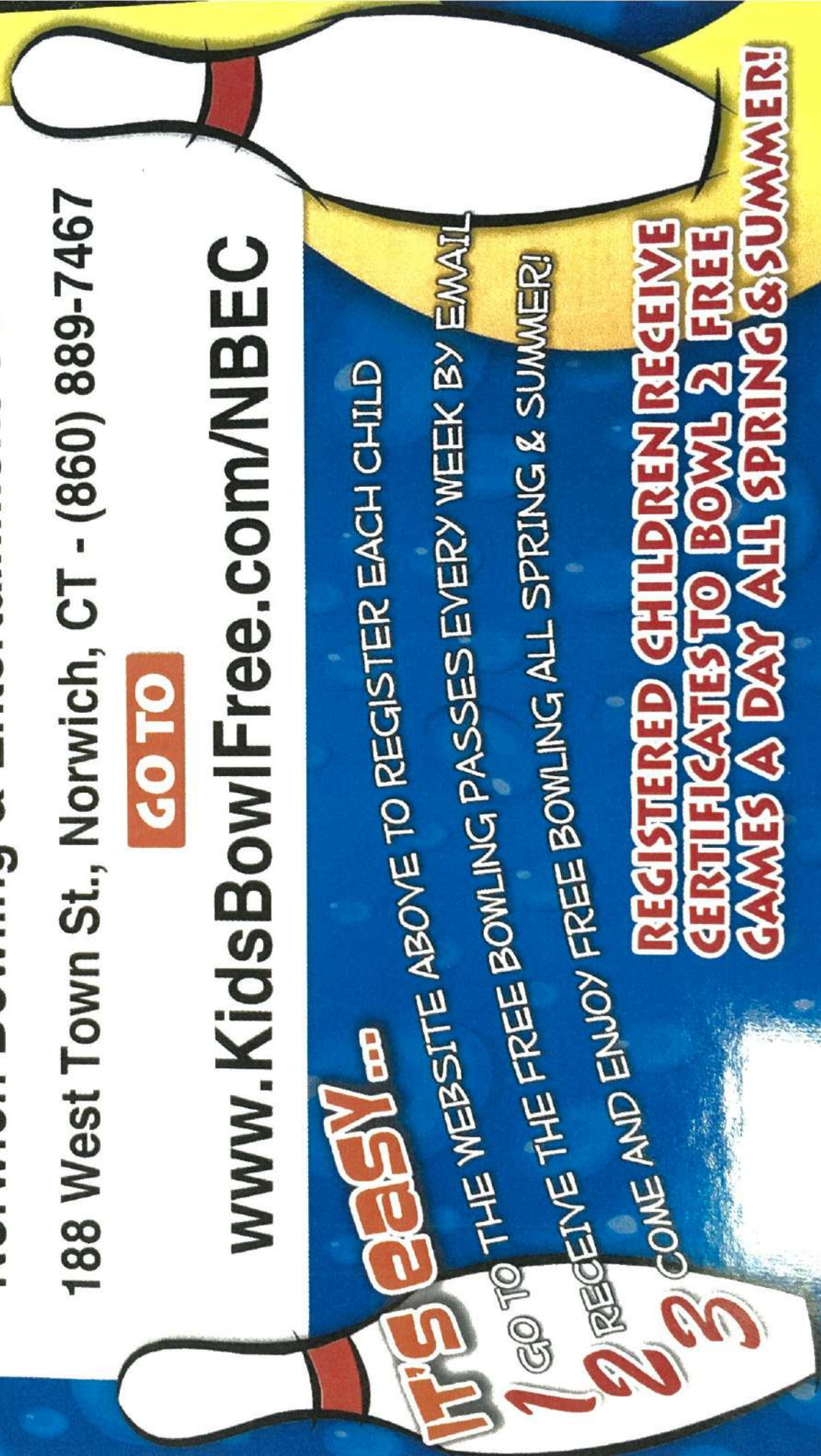

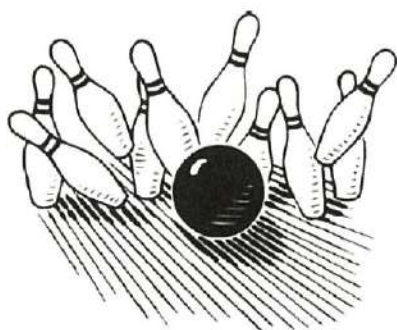

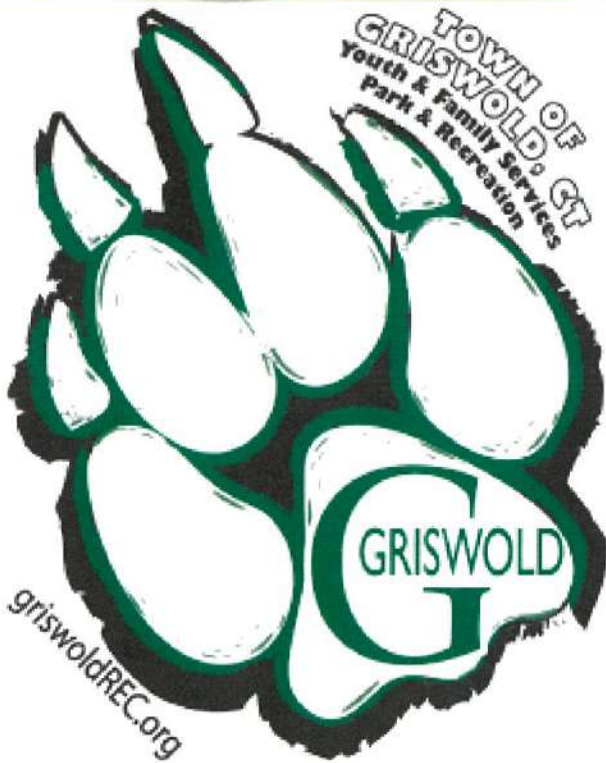

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Can I pay week to week?

A: Yes! Just need to pay for first week, you wish to attend, in advance then pay at-least 7-days in advance for other weeks.

Q: Do I have to go to each week?

A: No, just pick and choose which weeks you want.

Q: Do you offer financial assistance?

A: Yes, please come into Youth Center Mon - Fri, 2-5pm, bring in your 2017 Taxes

Q: Am I able to switch weeks?

A: Yes, just let us know at-least 7 days in advance.

Q: Can I pay online?

A: Yes, www.griswoldrec.org, click on Summer Camp link. Then "Sign Me Up!" Then create an account, register & pay.

Q: Can I pay cash or check at camp, the first day?

A: No, a new Board of Finance Policy states you must mail in checks or money orders (no cash) or drop either off at the Finance Office, second floor of the Town Hall. So, please pay for at-least first week ahead of time.

Q: How much does a week of camp cost?

A: \$90 = Griswold/Jewett City Resident and \$100 = Non-Resident

Q: Do you offer part-time rates or early care?

\$40 for whole week = Early Care (8-9am) (must pay for full week)

Part-Time (one day cost) = \$30 per day for Monday - Thursday, \$50 for Friday

(Credit Card can be done online but checks/cash must be done at the Finance Department)

Q: Can I sign up on the first day?

A: Yes, but you would have to register in person at the camp, THEN go drop off any checks, cash to the Finance Office at the Town Hall. (It's easier to pay in advance...)

Q: Can I mail in my application and payment?

A: Yes, download form on our Summer Camp website, mail in to:

(You must pay for at-least the first week of camp you choose)

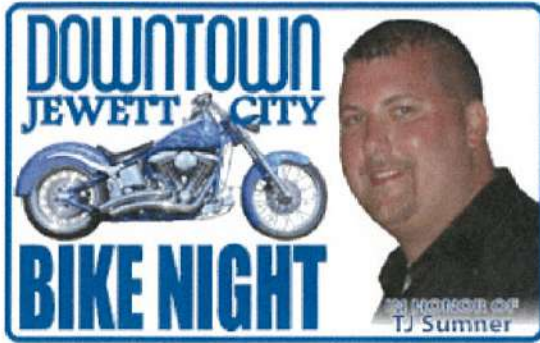
