FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Early Care??

A: Yes, drop off at 8 am is \$40 for first child OR \$75 per week fee for the WHOLE family!

Q: What does my child bring each day?

A: Glad you asked! 1 lunch, atleast 2 snacks & (optional) ice cream truck money.

Always have a change of clothes just in case! Always bring a reusable water bottle with child's name on it.

Please wear sneakers, no crocks or sandels. Kids could trip while playing.

Pick Up by 4 pm, if late past 4:15 pm then a charge of \$35 late pick up fee will be applied

Q: Can I pay week to week?

A: Yes! Just need to pay for first week, you wish to attend, in advance then pay at-least 7-days in advance for other weeks. More than two weeks late, you child will be removed from program.

Q: Do I have to go to each week?

A: No, just pick and choose which weeks you want.

Q: Do you offer financial assistance?

A: Yes, please come into Youth Center Mon - Fri, 2-5pm, bring in your 2018 Taxes

Q: Am I able to switch weeks?

A: Yes, just let us know at-least 7 days in advance.

Q: Can I pay online?

A: Yes, www.griswoldrec.org, click on Summer Camp link. Then "Sign Me Up!" Then create an account, register & pay.

Or if you attend last year, just click "Sign In" on the account screen.

Q: Can I pay cash or check at camp, the first day?

A: No, a new Board of Finance Policy states you must mail in checks or money orders (no cash) or drop either off at the Finance Office, second floor of the Town Hall. So, please pay for at-least first week ahead of time.

Q: How much does a week of camp cost?

A: \$95 = Griswold/Jewett City Resident and \$115 = Non-Resident

Q: Do you offer part-time rates or early care?

\$70 for whole week = Early Care (8-9am) (must pay for full week)
Part-Time (one day cost) = \$50 per day for anydays without a field trip.
(Credit Card can be done online but checks/cash must be done at the Finance Department)

Q. Can I sign up on the first day?

A. Yes, BUT you would have to register in person at the camp, THEN go drop off any checks, cash to the Finance Office at the Town Hall. (It's easier to pay in advance...)

Q. Can I mail in my application and payment?

A. Yes, download form on our Summer Camp website: www.griswoldyfs.com, mail in to: Griswold Finance Dept. (Summer Camp) 28 Main Street, Jewett City, CT 06351 (You must pay for at-least the first week of camp you choose)






