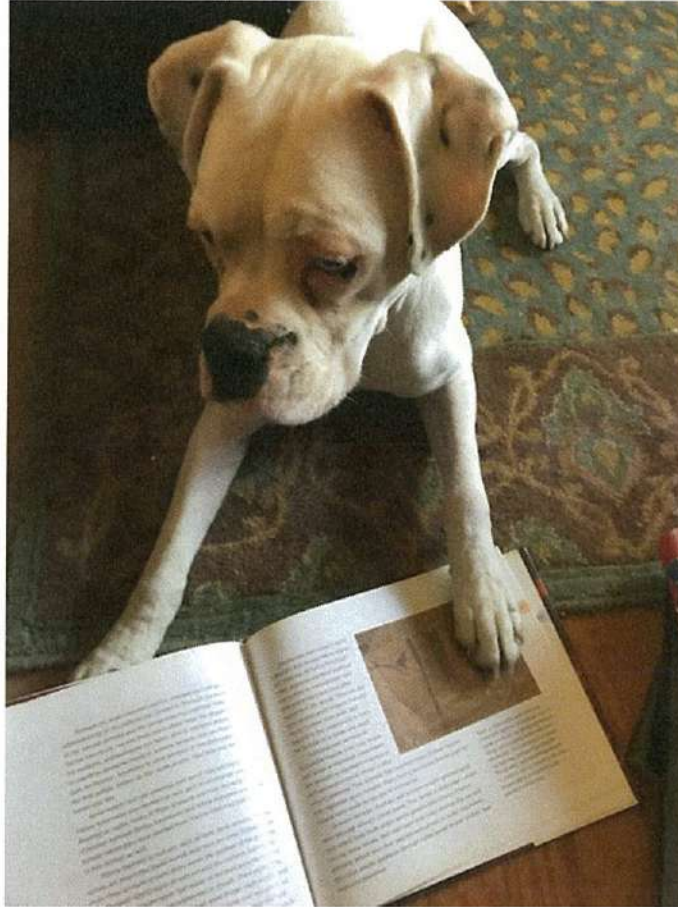

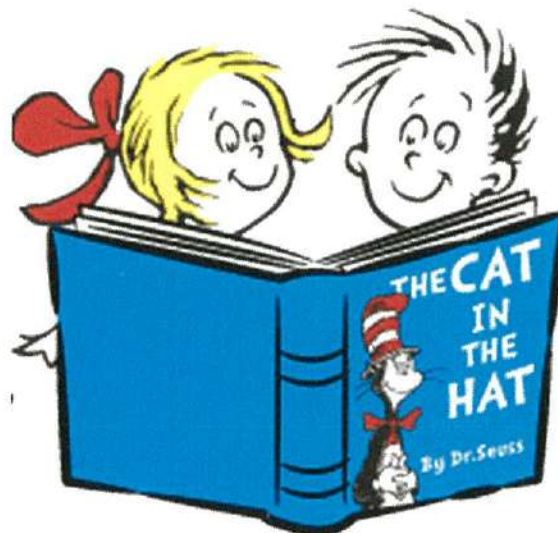

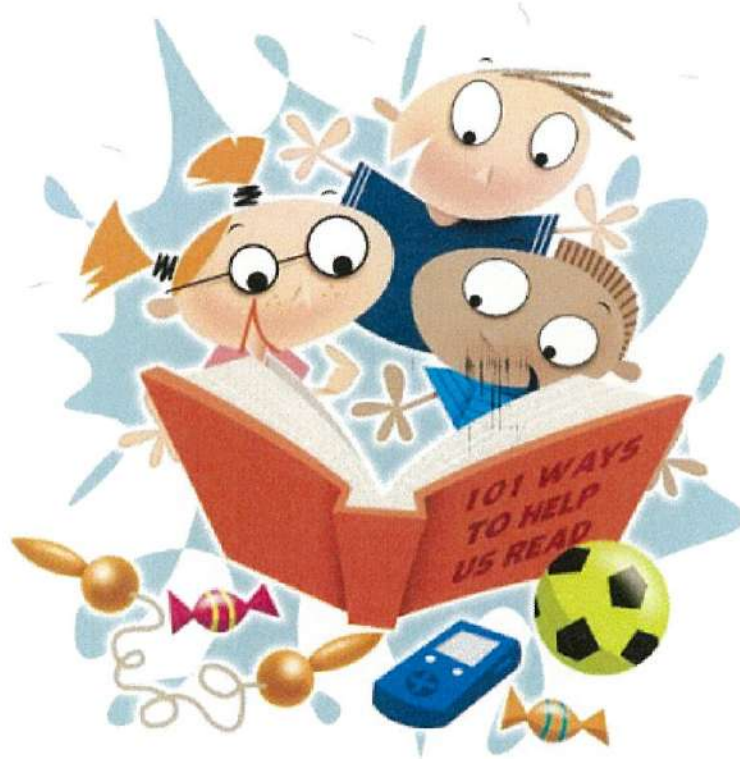

2020 Tryout Information – GRISWOLD HIGH SCHOOL

JCLL is a skills based league when placing players in each division. **All players age 7-12 must attend tryouts.** The following are the exception:

- If your child is league age 6 (August 31, 2013) and has played 1 year of T-Ball, they may try out for Farm System. **Any League Age 6 player not attending tryouts will be placed in T-Ball for the 2020 season.**

WE ARE HAVING A REDRAFT FOR ALL BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL

* Your child will be drafted and placed on a league team based on both their age and their skill level. Failure to attend tryouts jeopardizes a player's placement on a team. [Little League Rule Book IV (f)] If you have any questions, please contact VP of League Division.

9-10 year old Baseball: Mar 7th @ 10am– 11am (Arrive at 9:30 am)

9-12 year old softball: Mar 7th @ 1pm- 3pm (arrive at 12:30)
6-8 year old softball: Mar 7th @ 3pm-5pm (arrive at 2:30)

* JCLL is a non-profit organization and is run by volunteers. We rely on volunteers to run all the league operations, and this season we will be using JCLL volunteers to assist with the concession stand and a few Opening Day activities.

There is a \$25 concession stand volunteer fee per family. This is in addition to the registration fee. Two (2) hours of volunteer time in the concession stand is required per family for those that wish to receive fee back at end of season.

Note: There are only a few volunteer opportunities available on Opening Day. Sign up is first come, first served basis. JCLL will publish a sign up roster through sign up genius.

* Payments and registration forms not received online by February 27, 2020 will be considered late, and will be assessed the posted "Late Registration Fee" stated above. All registrations received after March 7, 2020 will be placed on a wait list.

NEW: Little League Baseball has decided to adopt the new bat standard for mandated use effective January 1, 2018. All Jewett City Little League baseball players must comply with the new bat standard.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Early Care??

A: Yes, drop off at 8 am is \$40 for first child OR \$80 per week fee for the WHOLE family!

Q: What does my child bring each day?

**A: Glad you asked! 1 lunch, atleast 2 snacks & (optional) ice cream truck money.
Always have a change of clothes just in case! Always bring a reusable water bottle with child's name on it.
Please wear sneakers, no crocks or sandels. Kids could trip while playing.**

Pick Up by 4 pm, if late past 4:15 pm then a charge of \$35 late pick up fee will be applied

Q: Can I pay week to week?

A: Yes! Just need to pay for first week, you wish to attend, in advance then pay at-least 7-days in advance for other weeks. More than two weeks late, you child will be removed from program.

Q: Do I have to go to each week?

A: No, just pick and choose which weeks you want.

Q: Do you offer financial assistance?

A: Yes, please come into Youth Center Mon - Fri, 2-5pm, bring in your 2019 Taxes

Q: Am I able to switch weeks?

A: Yes, just let us know at-least 7 days in advance.

Q: Can I pay online?

A: Yes, www.griswoldrec.org, click on Summer Camp link. Then "Sign Me Up!" Then create an account, register & pay. Or if you attend last year, just click "Sign In" on the account screen.

Q: Can I pay cash or check at camp, the first day?

A: No, a new Board of Finance Policy states you must mail in checks or money orders (no cash) or drop either off at the Finance Office, second floor of the Town Hall. So, please pay for at-least first week ahead of time.

Q: How much does a week of camp cost?

A: Without Early Bird Discount: \$120 = Griswold/Jewett City Resident and \$130 = Non-Resident

Q: Do you offer part-time rates

Part-Time (one day cost) = \$50 per day for anydays without a field trip.

(Credit Card can be done online but checks/cash must be done at the Finance Department)

Q. Can I sign up on the first day?

A. Yes, BUT you would have to register in person at the camp, THEN go drop off any checks, cash to the Finance Office at the Town Hall. (It's easier to pay in advance...)

Q. Can I mail in my application and payment?

A. No, sorry. Everything is done online or just come in to the Youth Center to get assistance in person.

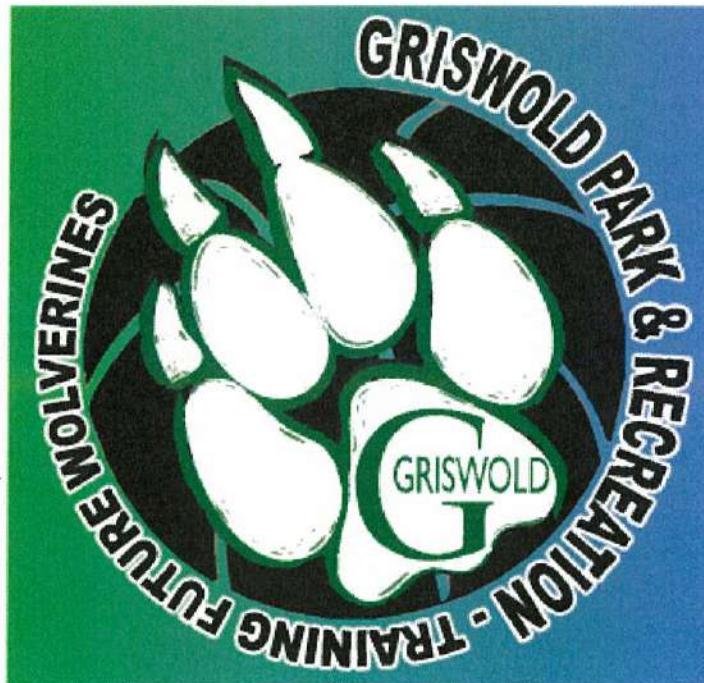
