	Level 1 Class (Ages 5-6) - Oct 2, 9, 23, 30 / Nov 6, 13 @ 6-7pm in the Griswold High School Cafeteria (12 students maximum)		
	This class is an introduction to dance movement. Basic fundamentals of posture, positions, and steps will be learned along with stretching and traveling across the floor. Each class will incorporate creative movement time in a safe and positive environment allowing the students to explore the steps learned in class and put together their own routines		
	both on their own. We will dance to upbeat age-appropriate music and utilizing props such as hula hoops, cones, and more. This class is a hour long and is designed for beginner level students with limited or no dance class experience.		
	Level 2 Class (Ages 7-8) - Oct 2, 9, 23, 30 / Nov 6, 13 @ 7-8pm in the Griswold High School Cafeteria (12 students maximum)		
	This class takes the Movin' Munchkins to the next level with a continued focus on stretching and posture, but will also incorporate more terminology and technique. Students will be given a folder and a notebook that they will be expected to bring to class each week to take some very basic notes and bring home pictures, stickers, and other dance-related information. There will be plenty of time for creative movement in each class in a safe and positive environment as well as other learning-through-play and movement-based games. This class is an hour long and is designed for beginner-intermediate students with some dance class experience.		
	*NEW Auditioning 101 for Young Performers (Ages 10+) - Oct 21, 28 / Nov 4, 18 @ 6-7:30pm		
	in the Griswold High School Chorus Room (12 students maximum) Auditioning for a show can be intimidating, overwhelming, and sometimes downright scary. This class will help ease the fears of the audition process by providing the basic tools for a confident, prepared, and memorable performance. Topics to be discussed are how to pick a proper monologue and/or song, presentation in front of the creative team, prepared techniques/terminology, how to handle a dance call, along with many other things. Each student will leave this class with a resume and head-shot. This class is 90 minutes long and is open to any level of experience.
