
#### THE GIFT OF THERAPY DOGS: REMEMBERING BELLA, WELCOMING RUDY

Jean has worked as a therapy dog handler for eight years--first with Bella, and now with Rudy. She is amazed by the ways these well-trained dogs know exactly what each person needs.
