We serve students from many countries such as Mexico, El Salvador, China, Vietnam, Mongolia, Ghana, Yemen, Congo, etc. All teachers are trained to help students develop their speaking, writing, and reading skills in English so they can graduate from high school and attend college. Classes are small in order for students to receive individual attention from teachers as they learn English. After school, students may participate in a tutorial program provided by students from the University of California at Berkeley, sports programs, or art classes. Oakland International also provide supports for immigrant families. Translation services are available for parents. Each student has an advisor who regularly calls and meets with parents. Oakland International will provide a safe and supportive environment that helps to prepare students new to the U.S. for college, work and participation in a democratic society.





MetWest is a small, innovative high school in partnership with Laney College. In our seventh year in the school year 2008-09, we serve 130 students from all corners of Oakland. Our student population consists of approximately 35% African American, 45% Latino, 15% Asian American, and 5% White. MetWest's approach to learning is grounded in our commitment to "educate one student at a time." With the teachers (called "Advisors") and family members, each student designs an educational program which includes two days a week at an internship and three days of academic study and interdisciplinary project work on campus. The internships give students a deep sense of how their interests materialize in the adult world, and provide an authentic environment and audience for their work. The courses our students take both at MetWest and Laney College support academic rigor in the internship-based and independent projects they develop.



The Oakland Emiliano Zapate Street Academy is an alternative high school which, for the past 35 years, has been serving students from multi-cultural backgrounds, and many of whom were at risk of failure in school prior to coming to our school. Our school provides the students with a college prep program while emphasizing community service, appreciation of diversity and a strong commitment to social justice. A consulting teacher works with each parent/guardian and student to develop an educational plan and communicates regularly to ensure the student is on rack. The school offers both a core academic day program and an extended day program with independent studies and enrichment programs. There are three steps to the application process. First, potential students and parents are invited to an orientation to the school's philosophy, instructional program, and rules. Next, the students will complete an application which includes an essay. The students must write why they wish to attend Street Academy. They also take placement tests in English languages arts and Mathematics. The tests are only for the purpose of placement in classes. Finally, the students will be scheduled for an interview with a committee consisting of a teacher and other students. The interview panel will determines acceptance of candidates.
