Computer Science is Everywhere!



Angelina, Mylo, and Suzi were sitting on the swings after school talking about the computer science activity they did with their teacher that day. Angelina said, "What we did today was fun, but I'm not sure if I'd want to write **programs** all day."

"My mom writes programs as part of her job in a science laboratory," says Suzi. "She told me that she wouldn't be able to do the work she does if it weren't for the help of the computer and her ability to tell it what to do. My mom and her lab partners need to keep track of a lot of information about the science experiments that they're doing."
