CORONA - <u>Corona High School (CHS)</u> was named an Amazon Future Engineer School. The partnership between Amazon and Corona High School aims to provide increased access to Computer Science courses and scholarship opportunities. The Amazon Future Engineer program offers funding for Computer Science related courses in high schools via curriculum provider Edhesive.

"We are super excited to be a part of the Amazon program," said Patrick Chao, CHS teacher.

Mr. Chao is also the STEM Coordinator and the Project Lead The Way (PLTW) Computer Science Pathway Lead. Corona High currently offers PLTW Intro to Computer Science and plans to use the Amazon curriculum to build the Advanced Placement (AP) Computer Science program.

"This is Corona High's first venture into AP computer science courses, bringing so much more opportunity to an underserved population of students," said Mr. Chao.

This partnership will provide an opportunity for students to connect with current Amazon Computer Software Engineers.


