Trigger	Response
Positive Case	<ul> <li>Nurse will conduct contact tracing for classrooms and PE.*</li> <li>If a student is identified as a close contact, the parent/guardian will be notified. (REVISED Forms will be used)</li> <li>If a staff member is identified as a close contact, the member will be notified.</li> <li>Any person, who is identified as a close contact and has been fully vaccinated, does not have to quarantine if s/he does not exhibit any symptoms.</li> <li>Any person, who is identified as a close contact and has tested positive for COVID-19 and fully recovered in the past three months, does not have to quarantine if s/he does not exhibit any symptoms.</li> <li>Any person, who is identified as a close contact and has not been fully vaccinated, will have to quarantine.</li> <li>*Note: Contact tracing will not be required on buses due to ventilation procedures.</li> </ul>
Quarantine/Isolation Rules	<ul> <li>Positive case –10 calendar days</li> <li>Close contact (unvaccinated)</li> <li>Quarantine away from school for 7 calendar days. May return on day 8 if symptom-free and received a negative COVID-19 test** on day 5, 6, or 7 of quarantine window.</li> <li>OR</li> <li>Quarantine away from school for 10 calendar days. May return on day 11 if symptom-free.</li> <li>Children/employees, who are not vaccinated, that live in a house with someone that is positive must isolate for 10 days, plus:         <ul> <li>Quarantine away from school for 7 additional calendar days. May return on day 8 if symptom-free and received a negative COVID-19 test** on day 5, 6, or 7 of quarantine window.</li> <li>Quarantine away from school for additional 10 calendar days. May return on day 11 if symptom-free.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Two or more COVID-19 symptoms (new loss of taste/smell, headache, chills, fever, muscle aches, sore throat, new cough, congestion, runny nose, shortness of breath, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting) will require you to isolate and stay at home for 10 days unless the student/employee provides documentation from his/her health provider that he/she can safely return to work/school.</li> <li>**Note:</li> <li>Negative home COVID-19 tests are NOT allowable or accepted for returning to school/work.</li> </ul>
Student returning from international travel	<ul> <li>Notify the school of return.</li> <li>Quarantine away from school for 7 calendar days. May return on day 8 if symptom-free and received a negative COVID-19 test** on day 5, 6, or 7 of the quarantine window.</li> <li>OR</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Quarantine away from school for 10 calendar days. May return on day 11 if symptom-free.</li> <li>Days will not count against attendance. Schoolwork will be provided.</li> </ul>
2 or more positive cases in a classroom within 48 hours	<ul> <li>Two or more positive cases from separate households are defined as an outbreak by ADPH.</li> <li>The entire class will be quarantined for 10 calendar days</li> <li>***Note: Any person, who is identified as a close contact and has been fully vaccinated, does not have to quarantine if s/he does not exhibit any symptoms.</li> </ul>
Multiple classrooms (≥50%) with one positive case in a school	Logistics will provide sanitization/disinfection for the affected area
15% of students identified as a positive case	<ul> <li>School is closed for 5 calendar days</li> <li>***Note: Rules for quarantine/isolation of positive cases and close contacts will still apply</li> </ul>
