

## Craig School Staff Scholarship

**PURPOSE:** The Craig School Staff is offering a scholarship(s) to a graduating senior(s) at Craig High School who plan on continuing his/her education at a post-secondary educational institution Fall Term after graduation. If funds are available, the Craig Education Association (CEA) may choose to award additional scholarships of varied value to additional seniors who continue their education at a post-secondary education institution. This scholarship fund was established to encourage Craig graduates to continue their education after high school.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURE:** Submit an application packet with the following information to Courtney Wood by 4:00 p.m., May 13, 2022.

- A. Complete Application with essay & budget
- B. Resume
- C. Transcript
- D. Two letters of recommendation - one from a community member not employed by the school.

**SELECTION CRITERIA:** Application packets will be judged according to the following criteria:

- A. Neatness of application (10 points)
- B. Essay (Content) (40 points)
- C. Essay (Grammar) (10 points)
- D. Budget (10 points)
- E. Resume (10 points)
- F. Letters of recommendation (10 points)
- G. Transcript (10 points)

**AWARD INFORMATION:** The recipients of the scholarships will be notified at their graduation ceremony. Checks will be mailed to the students' educational institutions after the first semester providing the students have maintained a 2.0 GPA or better and qualified as a full time student first semester. \*The recipients are required to send a copy of their grades, student ID number, and evidence of continued enrollment as a full time student to:

**A. Neatness of Application:**
