





IM K-5 Math: Pilot Curriculum Overview for Teachers

This module provides a preview of the IM Math curriculum to prepare teachers to pilot one or more units in the curriculum. It introduces participants to problem-based instruction and how it can be implemented in a classroom using the IM K–5 Math curriculum. Participants learn about the overall structure and design of the curriculum. They see an outline of a lesson plan and are exposed to other various components of the curriculum including centers, support for English language learners, support for students with disabilities, and routines. After this session, teachers will be ready to explore and pilot a single unit in their classrooms.

- Locate resources and opportunities to support access for students with disabilities and English learners.
