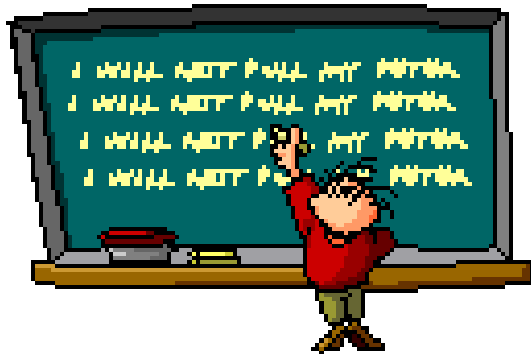


Discipline

All students are expected to conduct themselves according to the Lee County Master Discipline Plan and the Smiths Station High School Student Handbook.

Any student who fails to cooperate with staff members will be dropped from the summer credit recovery program. **NO MONEY WILL BE REFUNDED FOR ANY REASON.**

Pagers, cell phones, or any other electronic devices are not permitted. If students are in possession of an electronic device, the device will be taken up and returned to the student at the end of the summer credit recovery program (1st offense). The 2nd offense will result in the student being dropped from the summer credit recovery program.



Personal Appearance and Dress

All students attending the summer credit recovery program at Smiths Station High School will be expected to be neat and clean at all times and appropriately dressed for school.

Rules and Procedures

Attendance

Attendance is mandatory for credit to be awarded.

A student will be allowed one excused absence (must be a medical reason) during the summer credit recovery program. A make-up fee of **\$10.00 per hour** will be assessed for any missed time. The fee will be paid in the main office prior to the student being readmitted to class upon his/her return.

A tardy fee of **\$5.00** will be assessed if a student is less than 10 minutes late to school. If a student is more than 10 minutes late the following fee schedule will apply:

11-60 minutes-	\$10.00
1:01-2:00-	\$20.00
2:01-3:00-	\$30.00
3:01-4:00-	\$40.00
4:01-5:15-	\$50.00

All tardy fees are due prior to being readmitted to class. Fees will be paid in the office.

A student will be dropped from the summer school roll if a 2nd absence occurs (unless prior approval is given by the Program Coordinator. **The \$60.00 make-up fee will still apply. A student will be dropped from the roll if he/she is tardy more than three (3) times during the entire summer session.**
