5. Student must submit every year by **JUNE 15** for their 4 years of college, a yearly update with a copy of their transcript that shows a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester; their GPA maintained at 2.5 or above; proof of continued enrollment, and a letter of intent to majoring in production agriculture.

***PLEASE NOTE:** any change in major out of production agriculture will be cause for relinquishment of these Scholarship monies.
