Mr. Corcoran explained the procedure for the Turn Around functioning school Plan for Crosby High School. Someone from the Counselor will be represented for the State of Connecticut. A letter was sent to the state about how things on the council is being handled for necessary change.

The Turn Around Plan is submitted from transitional plan to block scheduling. Each class will be extended by 30 minutes, 5 classes on a rotating basis. There will be an extended year with A P Classes, advanced Classes. Block scheduling is to be academically, design a small limited learning restructure for other grades 10, 11, 12. All students will have the same teachers in their grade level. It is a means to know the students better to develop more of a sense of a community environment. Everything will start next year.

Crosby New improvement Changes For Success

- 1. Uniforms will be worn by the student
- 2. Uniforms will be based on colors by grades
- 3. Parents will have input on colors of uniforms
- 4. Example students will be recognized in various locations
- 5. Additional security may be necessary communication and accountability
- 6. General in need of Special Education is a different strategy
- 7. Academy locations will be throughout the school
