In this sentence, upon is the preposition, and dock is the object of the preposition.

Enrichment: Using Latin to Define English

Directions Read the information below. Answer the questions that follow and complete the activity.

Words are often built from smaller parts called roots and prefixes.
Roots, such as *port*, are parts that can sometimes stand alone as smaller words but sometimes join with other parts to form longer words. Prefixes, such as *trans*, are word parts placed at the beginning of a word or word root to add meaning to the word.
