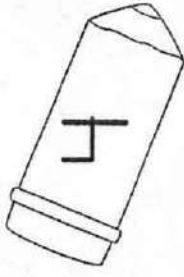


The illustration contains the following sight words:

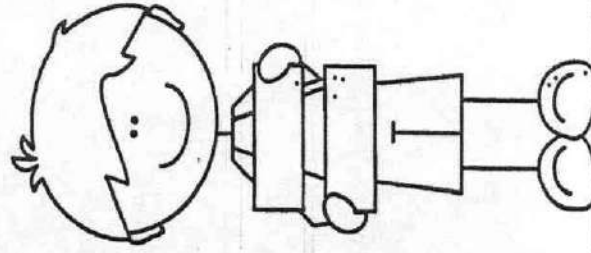

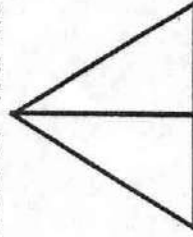

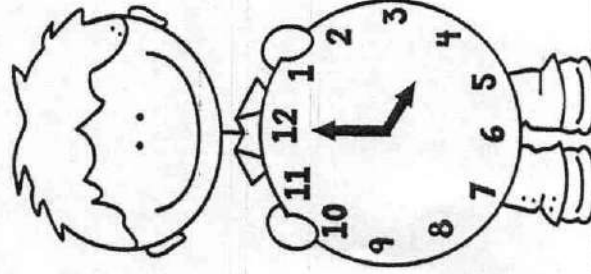
