### Targeted Goals from Stage 1:

Examine a topic or genre to better understand a piece of art or artist in relation to time and place

Create works of art to personally engage in the artistic process and/or communicate meaning

**Content Knowledge:** Idea generation, Design and Product Creation

**Vocabulary:** Photo Essay, Documentary Photography, Aesthetically, Culturally and Socially Evaluative

**Skills:** Students will apply knowledge of camera functions to creating images for a series of thematically connected images that tell a story.
