Dear Parents,

In order to guarantee your child, and all the children, the excellent learning environment they deserve, I am utilizing the following management plan. During the first week of school, the children will learn these classroom rules.

Classroom Rules:

- 1. Treat each other with respect and kindness (look at and listen to others, raise your hand and wait your turn to speak, help each other, work quietly, be polite-say "please" and "thank you").
- 2. Respect and obey the teacher.
- 3. Be safe.
- 4. Be responsible for yourself (keep hands to self, keep up with your things).

Consequences for misbehavior:

I will give one reminder. If the child continues, he/she must "pull" his/her card (index card) and bring it to the teacher. I will date and write a brief explanation of what happened. Immediate and natural consequences are often the best for young children. If disrupting the group, the child sits away from the class. If too rough on the playground, the child will sit out for a time. At the end of each week, the index card will come home for the parent to sign. A clean card will have a smiley or sticker attached. Please follow up at home to reinforce our class rules.

1st consequence – verbal reminder

2nd consequence – "pull" the card, receive a consequence.

3rd consequence – "pull" the card, a longer consequence and a note goes home 4th consequence – "pull" the card, a phone call or a parent conference is scheduled 5th consequence – The child and teacher will go to see an administrator.

Each Friday the students will bring home his/her card. Please sign and return it on Monday. We will be working together this year to monitor your child's classroom behavior. Please go over the rules and the consequences with your child so s/he knows we are all focusing on the same set of rules. Sign the tear-off portion below and have your child also sign the rules and return the portion tomorrow. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to write me a note or ask at Parent Night. I appreciate your cooperation.
