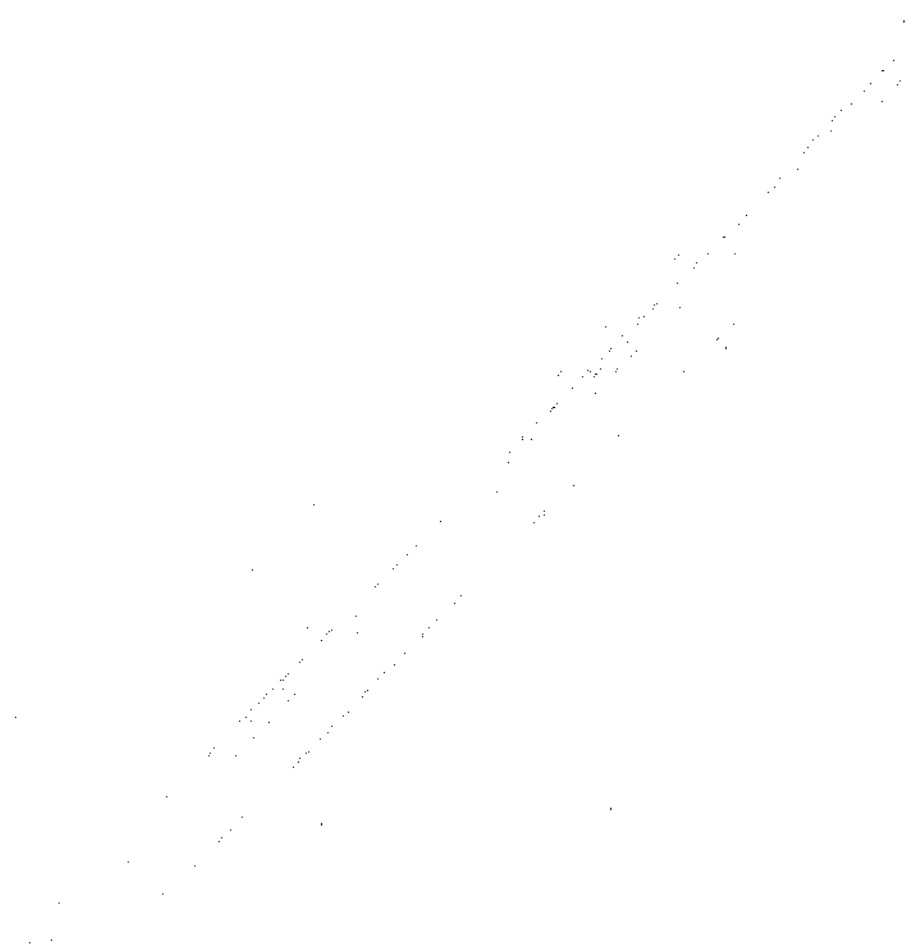




## Windows OS AnyConnect VPN Setup

1. Go to <https://vpn.arkansas.gov>
2. You will see Cisco Secure Desktop. **Click Download**

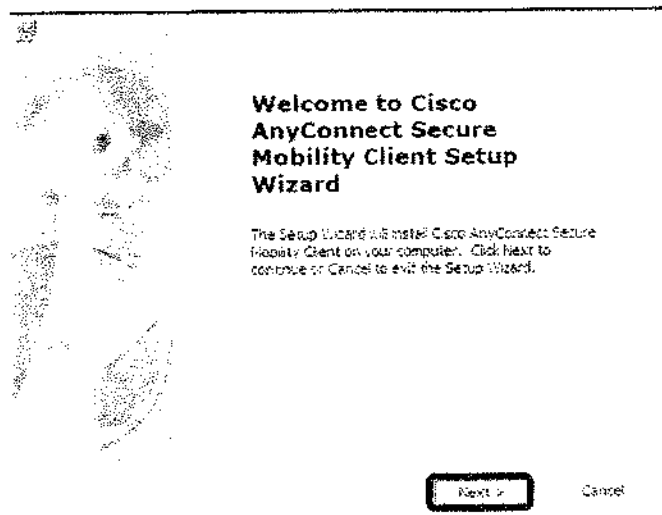

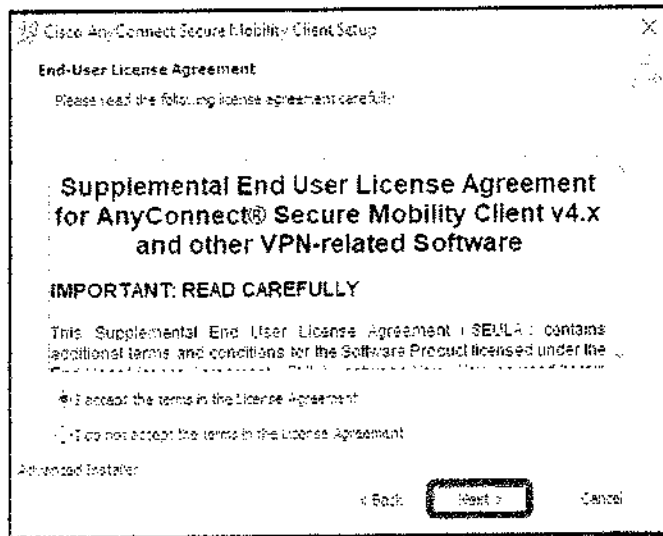

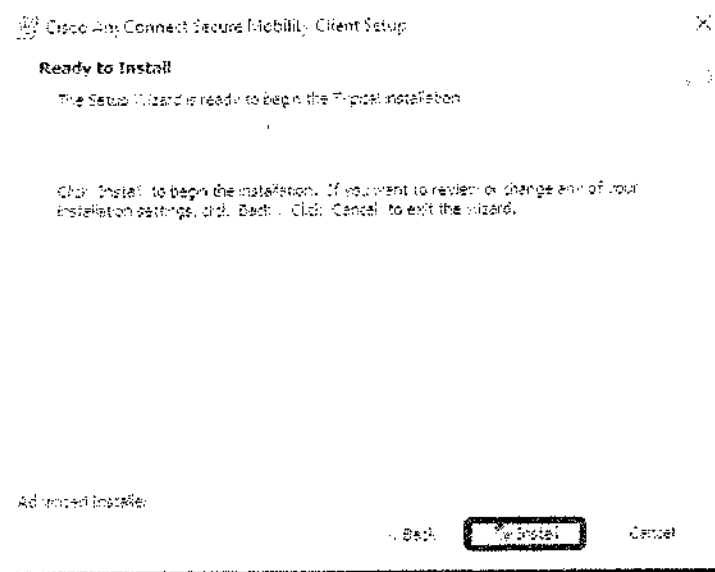
6. Run the download. You will see a welcome screen. **Click Next**



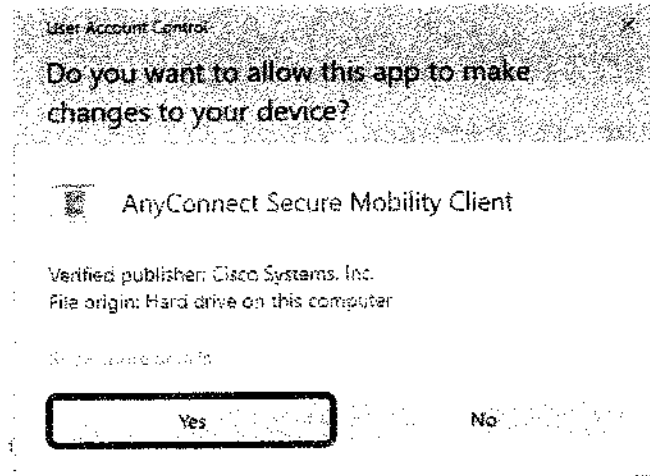
7. Accept the EULA and Click Next



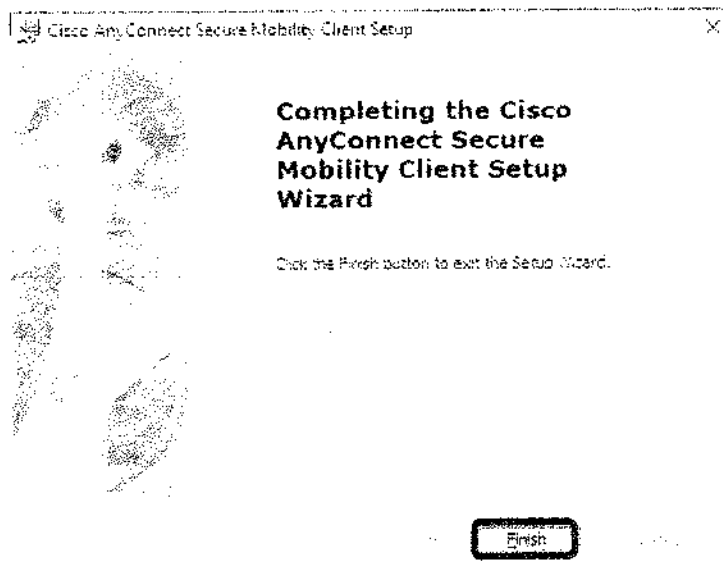
8. Next, Click Install



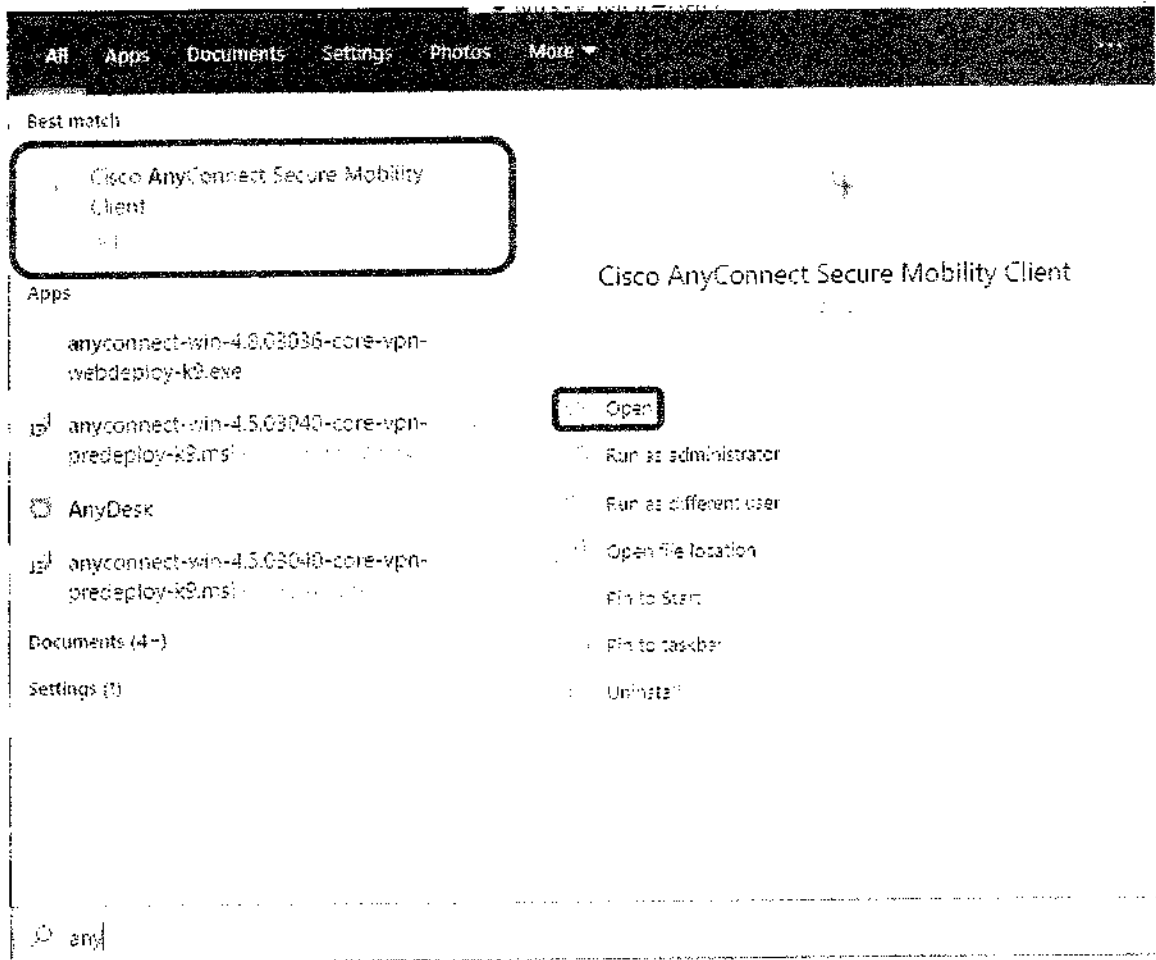
9. On the UAC popup, Click Yes



10. Once the install is finished, Click Finish

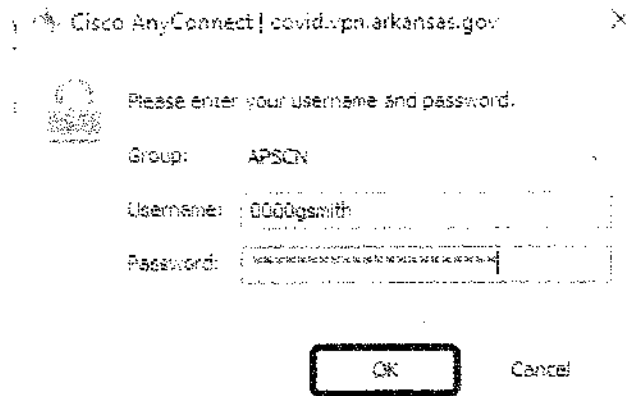


## 11. Search for Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client



## 12. Type in the URL [vpn.arkansas.gov](http://vpn.arkansas.gov) and Click Connect

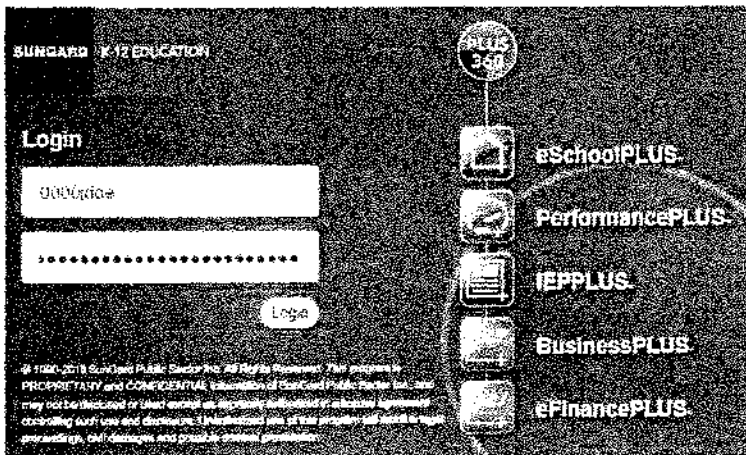
13. Make sure you select **APSCN** from the group. Enter in your **SSO Credentials**. Click **OK**

14. You will see a notification showing you are **Connected**.

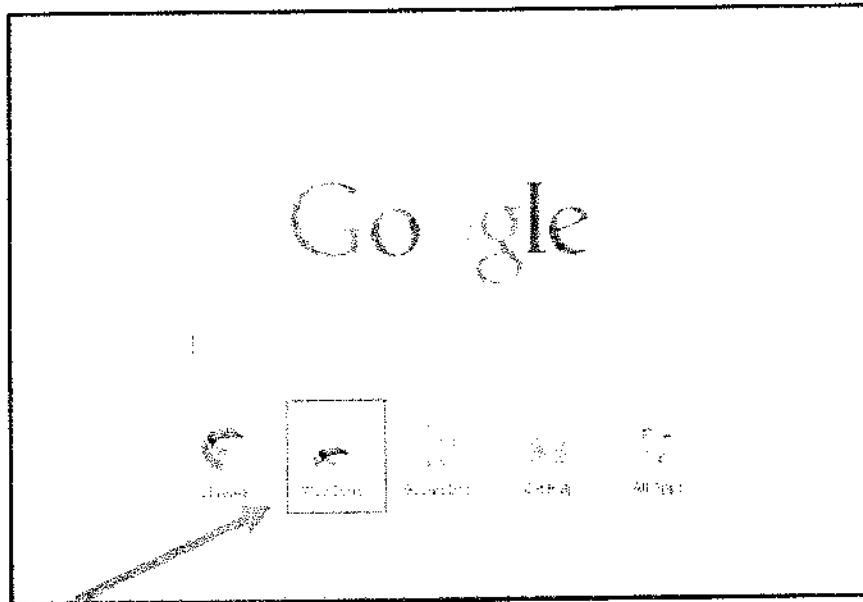


15. You should be connected to the State Network and can access the APSCN environment.

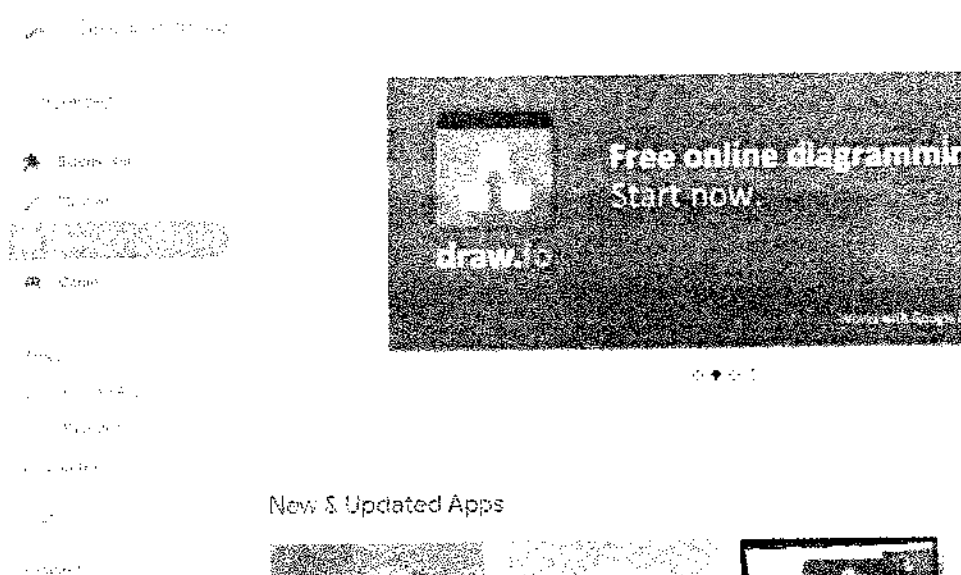


## Chrome OS AnyConnect VPN Setup

1. Click the "Launcher" icon on the Google Chromebook desktop. Locate then open the Web Store

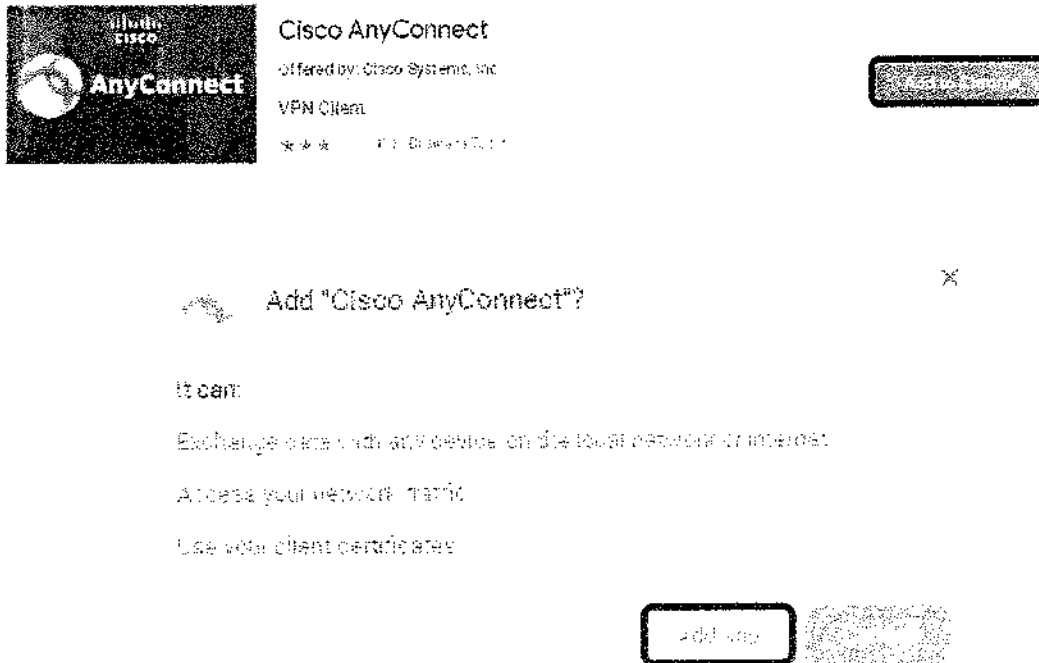


2. Using the search bar, search for Cisco AnyConnect

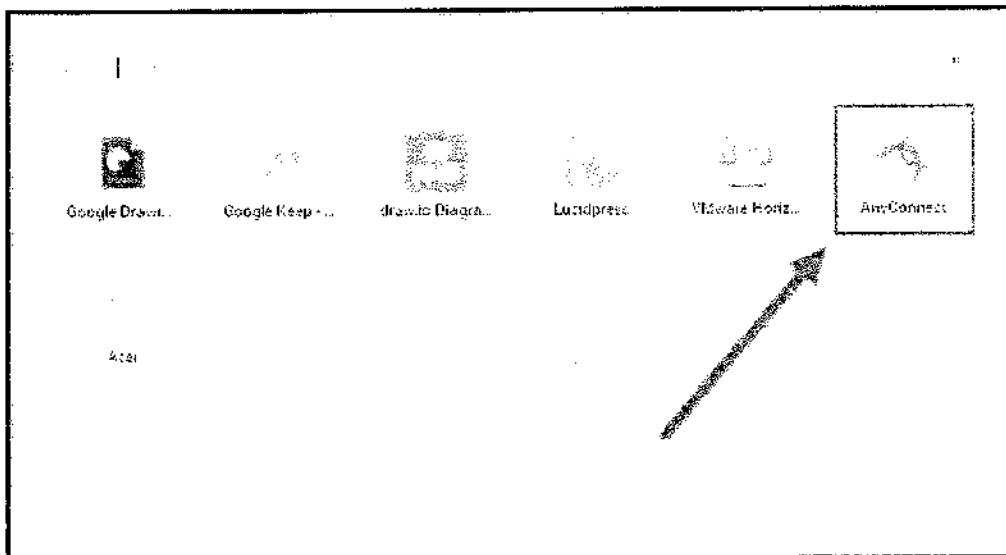




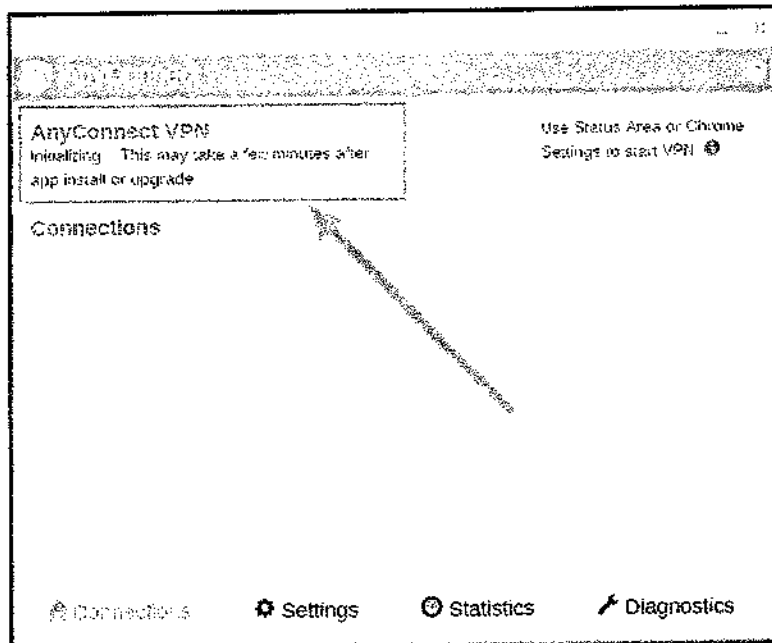
3. Click the **Add to Chrome** button to install the Cisco AnyConnect client on your Chromebook



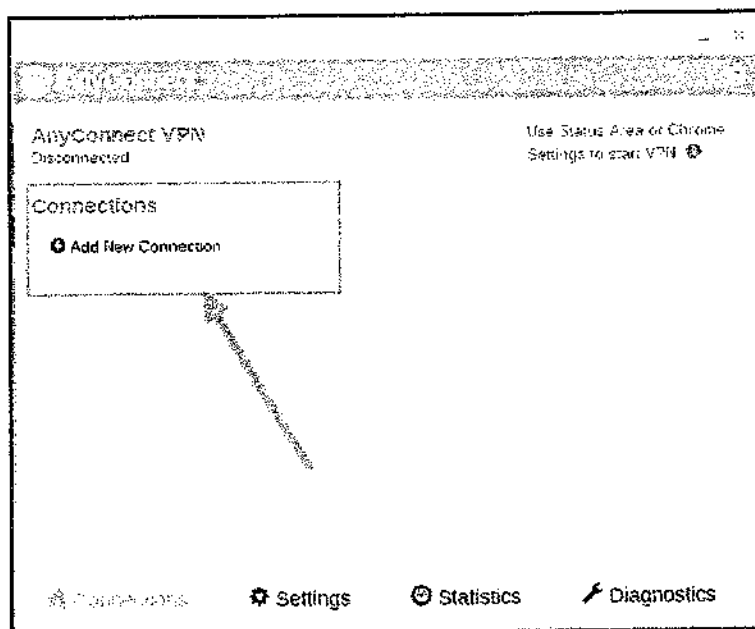
4. Once the Cisco AnyConnect app is installed, AnyConnect icon will appear on your application screen. Click the **AnyConnect** icon to configure the VPN client



5. The VPN client will go through an initializing state. Please wait while the client is initializing.  
***This may take 2-3 minutes to complete***



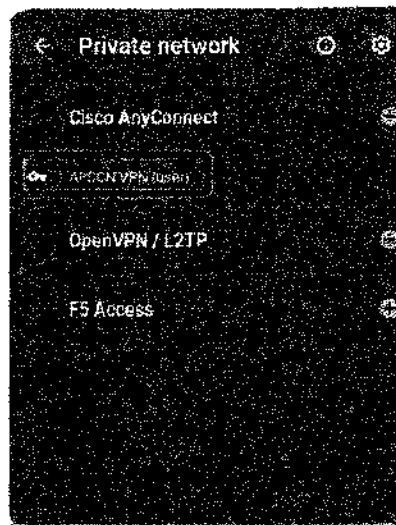
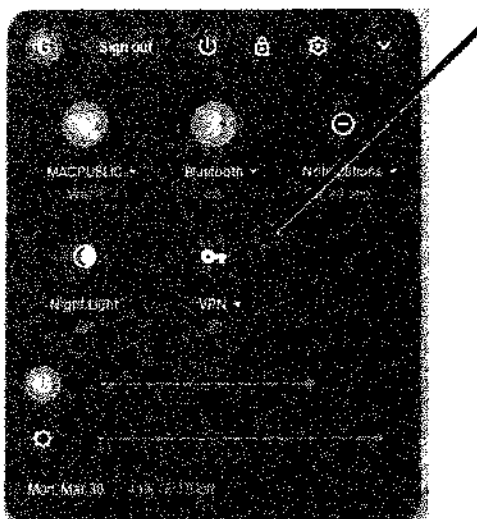
6. Once available, click the **Add New Connection** button to configure the VPN client

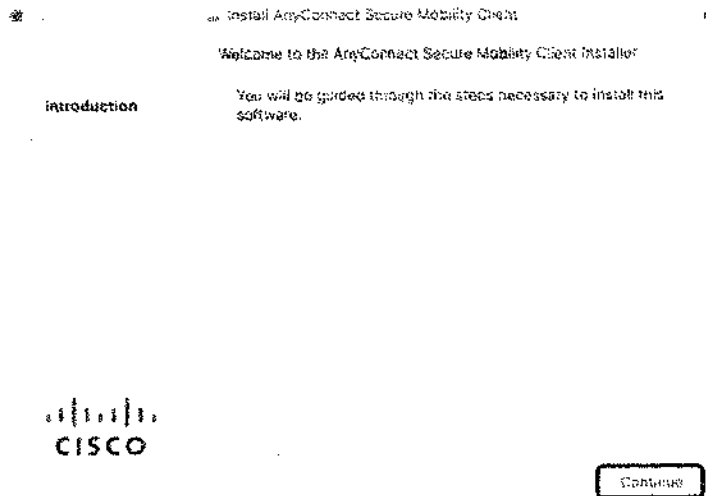
6. Go to Downloads and double click the **AnyConnect.dmg**



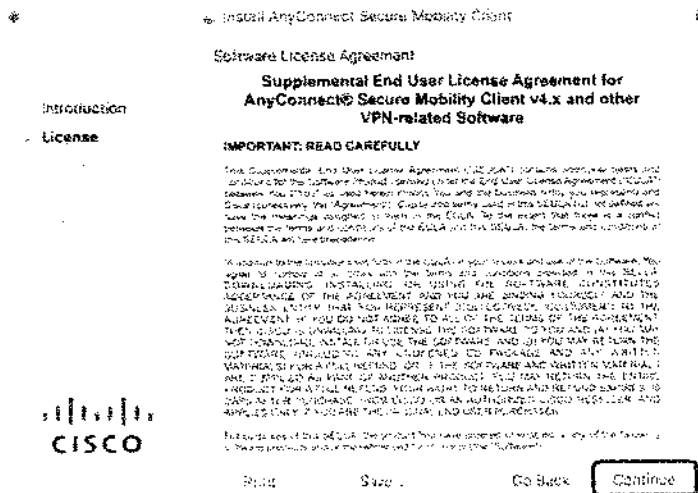
7. Double Click on the AnyConnect.pkg

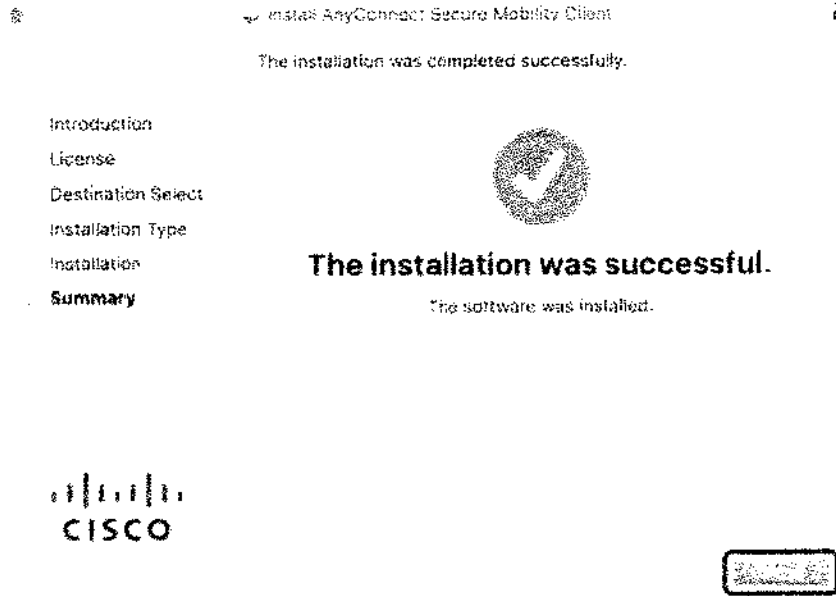

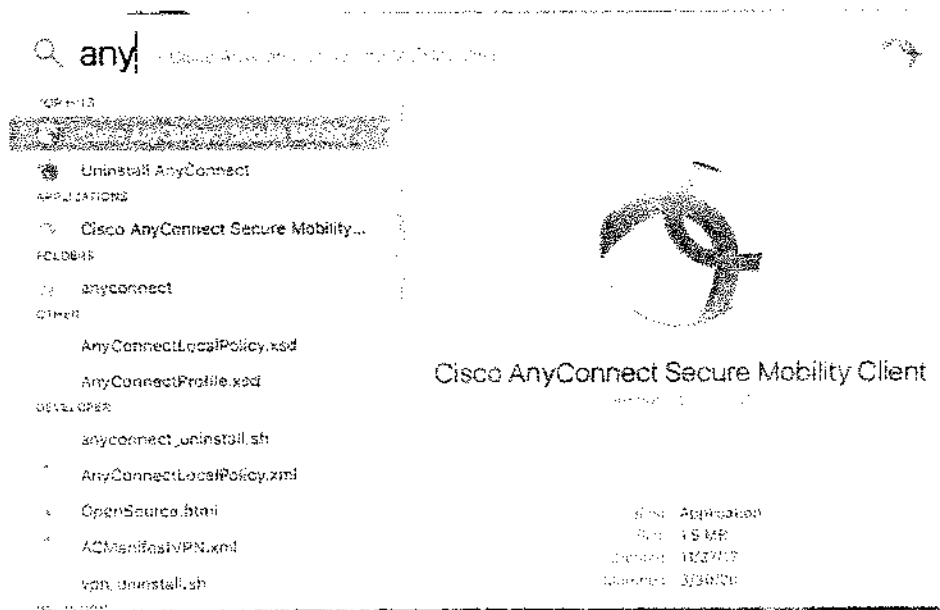

13. In Finder, search for Cisco AnyConnect and click on the Application

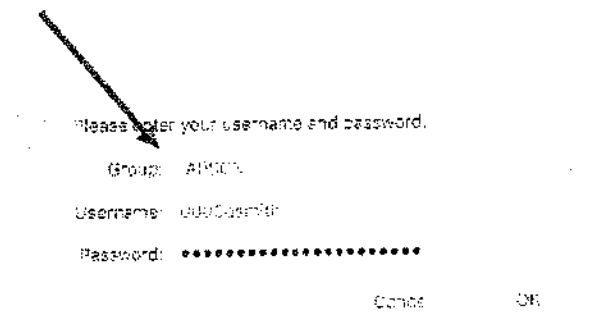

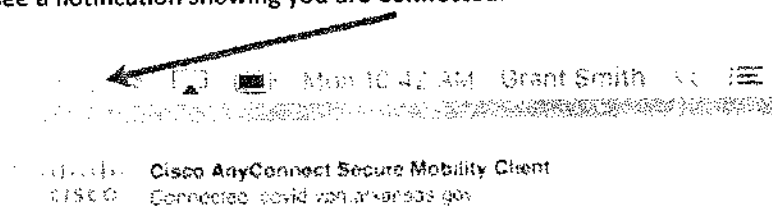
