Down Syndrome



Birth Defects




In this picture it is showing a babies belly button sticking out.




In this picture the babies eyes are wide spread apart, the ears are low set, and the tongue is sticking out due to low muscle tone

My face might be different, But my feelings the same, I laugh and I cry And I take pride in my gains.


I was sent here among you, To teach you to love, As god in the heavens Looks down from above.
