## D. Reports

# 1. Summer School Information - Marcia Farabee, Director of School Curriculum

Mrs. Marcia Farabee, Director of School Curriculum, presented the board with Gadsden City Schools Summer School Guidelines for 2022.

- Gadsden City Schools will offer a limited summer school program for students in grades 6-12 for the purpose of earning credit that may be applied toward promotion and graduation requirements.
- High School GCHS will hold a five-week session for students in grades 9-12. The sessions will begin on June 1, 2022 and end on June 30, 2022.
- Middles School Gadsden Middle School will hold a five-week session for students in grades 6-8. The sessions will begin on June 1, 2022 and end on June 30, 2022.
- A non-refundable registration fee of \$25.00 is due by May 31, 2022
- Registration forms are available online and through the counselor's office at all four schools. The principal or counselor of the home school must approve all registration forms. Payment in full must be made before registration is complete, seats are reserved, and before summer school begins. A limited number of seats will be available for each subject. Priority will be given to those students who fail two classes.
- Make-up work may be given if the student's absences are excused by the
  principal due to personal illness, death in immediate family, court demands,
  or other extraordinary circumstances. Written excuses must be provided for
  all absences.
- More than two absences (excused or unexcused) during the summer will result in automatic dismissal with no credit. Students must make up time missed through a virtual program. Tardiness to school/class will not be tolerated in summer school. Excessive tardiness may result in dismissal without credit. No tuition will be refunded in cases of dismissal. (3 tardies - 1 absence)

- Students must remain in designated areas at all times classes are not in session.
- The summer school program will meet all Standards of Accreditation of the State Department of Education and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.
- The Code of Student Conduct for Gadsden City Schools will be fully applicable and enforced during the summer school session.
- Summer school teachers must have a valid teaching certificate. An application for employment can be made to Marcia Farabee, Director of Curriculum and Instruction, Gadsden City Board of Education.
- Curriculum for summer school will be based on College and Career
  Readiness Standards, and Alabama Course of Study Content Standards.
  Curriculum will be delivered using a hybrid method with both face-to-face
  and virtual requirements. Students will use online platforms, including
  Edgenuity, IXL, Progress Learning. Students must complete and master
  course objectives in order to receive credit for the course.
- Administrator in-person hours 7:15-12:45; Staff in-person hours 7:30-12:30. Virtual hours 1:00 3:00.
- Student in person hours 8:00-12:00; virtual 1:00-3:00.
- Nineteen Instructional Days In-person days: June 1-3; Monday-Thursday June 6-30. Virtual days: June 10, 17, 24.
